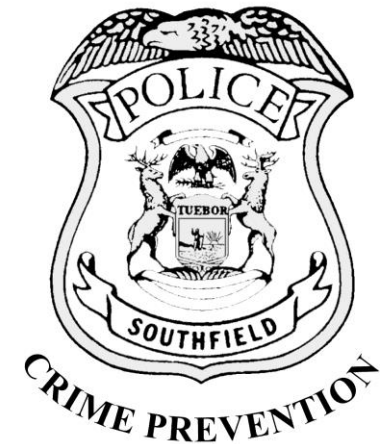

## Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
12/21/2021 3:17pm	24000 Telegraph Rd. (Commercial- Storage)	Lock was cut off.	R/P states TV and Jewelry were taken from her storage unit. Occurred sometime in the past week. No suspect information.
12/23/2021 12:39pm	24000 Telegraph Rd. (Commercial- Storage)	Roll up door was pried off the track. Original lock was removed and replaced with another lock.	Officer met with R/P reference B&E of her storage locker. It appeared that the roll up door was off the track and damaged do to prying. There was a lock securing the storage locker that didn't belong to the R/P. After checking with management, it was discovered that the lock was one of their locks that you can purchase. The lock wasn't purchased by victim. No suspect information. <b>Note:</b> There have been several break-ins at this location recently.

No forced entry, most likely a key was used.</p>	<p>R/P advised that on the evening of 12/24/2021 at approx. 11:15pm he arrived to secure the business for the evening. R/P advised that Christmas Eve is the only evening the business is closed until the following morning. R/P showed up the following morning and discovered someone had gotten into the business and stolen an undisclosed amount of cash and rolled coin from several cash drawers and a safe.</p> <p>A review of the business CCTV Video showed the following: At 2:13am two suspects were observed on foot coming from the rear alley. Both suspects were very slim built, about 5'11.</p> <p><b>Suspect#1</b> is described as wearing a black sweat suit, with a gray hoodie, gray gloves.</p> <p><b>Suspect#2</b> Gray hoodie, white tennis shoes, white gloves. Both suspects were wearing disposable cloth booties, and white masks.</p> <p>Both suspects are observed entering the business through the west side door and taking cash from several registers including the lottery cash drawer. At 2:22am both suspects are observed exiting the business the same way they entered.</p> <p>A dark in color mini- van is seen picking up the two suspects and it fled S/B on Telegraph Rd. Most likely a third suspect was driving the mini-van. Investigation is on-going.</p>

12/20/2021 9:42pm	26000 Emmett St.	Entry was not made.	<p>On 12/20/2021 at 9:42pm, Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of Emmitt for a possible Home Invasion. Dispatch advised Officers that a subject tried to open the back window of the home. The reporting party retreated to her bedroom.</p> <p>Officers arrived on scene and didn't locate any suspect(s) or any signs of force or attempted forced entry on the residence.</p> <p>Officers reviewed the home owner's surveillance video. Officer overheard a loud noise and then observed a motion that looked like a person moving past the front side of her rear sun porch entry door glass. Officer also overheard a male's voice speaking for a couple of seconds. The speech was unintelligible. The subject then disappears from the frame.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> R/P just moved into the residence and the residence was vacant prior to that.</p>

<p><b>Special Attention: Shooting</b>  12/23/2021 5:49pm  <b>16000 Block of North Park Dr.</b>  <b>(Apartments)</b>  On 12/23/2021, Southfield Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of North Park Dr. (Apartment Complex) for shots heard. An anonymous R/P heard gunshots and saw two 20- year old B/M's running from the lobby area near the leasing office. The subjects entered an unknown vehicle and fled the apartment complex.  Upon arrival, officers located several spent shell casings and bullet holes in the building. While on scene, officers were notified that a subject was at an area hospital with multiple gunshot wounds. The Detective Bureau was notified and responded. **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers

**Domestic Felonious Assault/ LFA- 1- Arrest**  
**20000 Lahser Rd.**  
**(Apartments)**

On 12/24/2021, Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Lahser Rd. (Apartments) for a Domestic Incident. Victim reported her ex-boyfriend struck her vehicle with his, stole multiple items and fled the scene last seen traveling N/B on Lahser Rd.

R/P (victim) states she had just left SPD front desk after making a Threats Complaint against her boyfriend. She was with her two cousins when she returned to her apartment.

As she was dropping her two cousins off at their car her boyfriend spotted her and drove his White Cadillac Escalade towards her Black Cadillac XT4. Victim attempted to flee from her boyfriend but he deliberately struck her vehicle, disabling it. Victim exited out of her front passenger door. Her boyfriend exited his vehicle and verbally threatened her. The boyfriend then reached into victim's vehicle and grabbed her purse. He removed her cellphone, took her Cadillac XT4 key, Chevrolet Cruze key, and house keys. Suspect threw the purse back into victim's vehicle and fled the area.

Victims two cousins witnessed and confirmed that victim's boyfriend deliberately struck her vehicle and then took belongings from her purse that was inside her vehicle. The suspect later came into the front desk of the Southfield Police Department. He was questioned and was taken into custody for Felonious Assault with a Motor Vehicle and Larceny from Auto. TOT Southfield Jail, processed and lodged.

### **Special Attention:**

#### **Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

#### **How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
