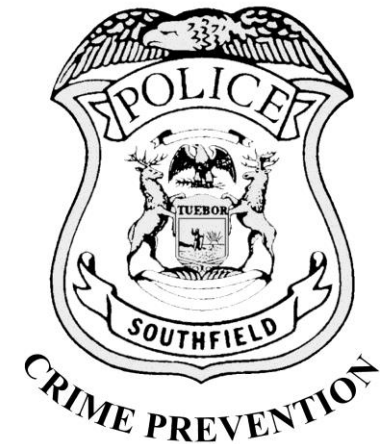
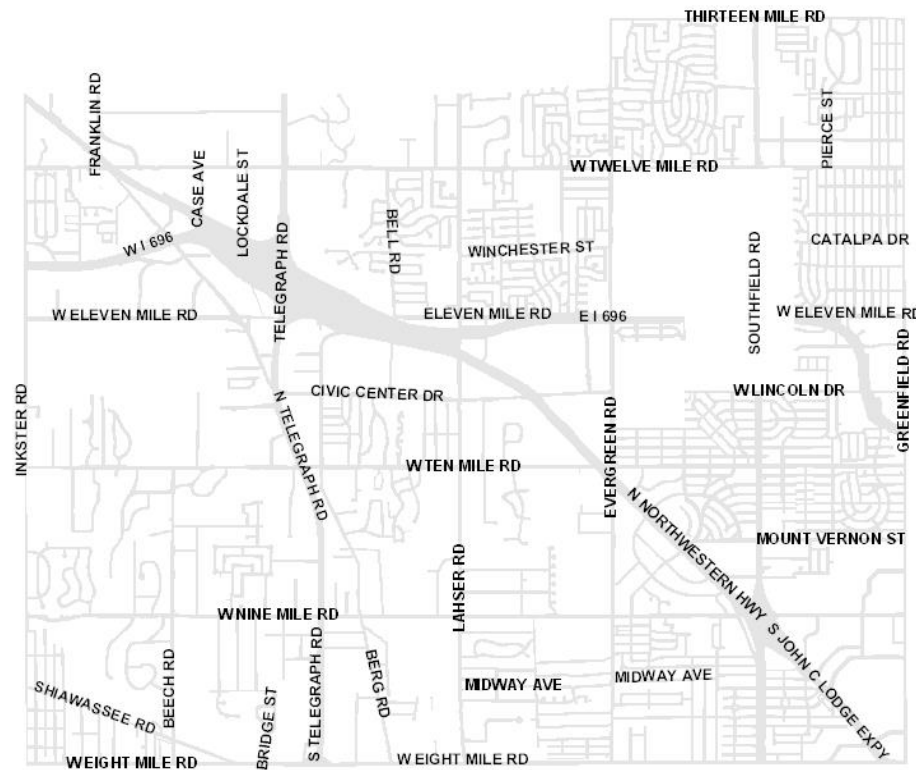

The R/P advised that her mother's ex-boyfriend was at the residence throwing stuff around. The suspect left prior to Officers arrival. Investigation revealed that R/P's ex-boyfriend forced entry into R/P's residence by kicking in the front door. After entry was made the ex-boyfriend went on a rampage damaging several things throughout the home, including knocking over the Christmas Tree and assaulting the R/P. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the scene to take photos of damages to the home and items within. Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

On 12/21/2020 at 6:43pm, Officers were dispatched to pharmacy in the 21000 Block of W Eleven Mile Rd. regarding a subject who had assaulted a store employee and stole some merchandise from the store. The suspect was last seen behind the businesses on the east side of Lahser Rd, just North of M-10. Suspect was a B/M, wearing a black backpack, a black winter coat, blue jeans, and a black ski cap. Officers located a subject matching this description walking through the parking lot in the 26000 Block of Northwestern. The subject was detained until Officers investigating at scene brought store employee from business for a show-up with the suspect. After observing the subject, the employee immediately identified the subject as the one that stole merchandise from the store. Investigation revealed that the suspect assaulted two employees during the incident. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Retail Fraud II & A&B.

The male half left the scene in a Black Chrysler 300.  Officers arrived on scene and located female victim. She had been assaulted by her boyfriend and had sustained numerous injuries requiring hospitalization. The victim stated her boyfriend punched her numerous times, knocked her down onto the floor and pistol whipped her with his handgun. He also took victims cell phone and smashed it prior to fleeing the apartments.  A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and took photos of victim's injuries.</p>	<p><b>Aggravated/ Felonious Assault- 1- Arrest</b>  12/23/2020 7:07pm  <b>25000 Block of Evergreen Rd.</b>  Officers were dispatched to 25170 Evergreen Rd. (Restaurant) for an armed subject. Dispatch advised responding Officers the R/P stated her husband threatened her with a gun and she ran inside the business for safety. The suspect arrived in a Black Nissan Altima.  Officers arrived on scene and observed suspect vehicle leaving the parking lot N/B on Evergreen Rd.  The vehicle was stopped and the suspect was detained w/o incident. The subject was asked if he had any weapons on him? He told Officers that it was in the driver's door. Officers recovered a handgun from the driver's door of the vehicle. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was on scene and collected evidence. Officers were dispatched to the Gas Station at Telegraph and Twelve Mile for a possible Felonious Assault. Dispatch advised Officers responding that the R/P arrived at the Gas Station in a Red Ford Mustang and was hiding behind the counter after being followed by subjects in three vehicles who pointed a gun at him.

The three vehicles were: Black Cadillac CTS, a Black Chrysler 300 and a Gray Mountaineer.

The vehicles stopped following R/P when he pulled into the gas station and were last seen in the Mall parking lot adjacent to the gas station.

Officers arrived on scene and none of the vehicles described by R/P were located.

When Officers interviewed R/P it was unclear exactly where the F/A occurred and he couldn't explain why the three cars were following him or why anyone would point a gun at him.

R/P stated that the subject that pointed the gun at him was in the Black Cadillac CTS. (driver)

R/P described the driver and passenger as black males in their early twenties. Both males were wearing surgical masks and R/P was unable to provide any physical description of them other than

During questioning of front right passenger, she was making furtive movements so that Officer couldn't see inside her purse. Officer asked female if she had any weapons on her. She stated no several times and then stated she didn't want to lie and was open carrying a handgun in her purse. The purse was to the left of this female and you could not see that there was a handgun in the purse. Officer asked the female if she had a CPL. She stated no. A handgun was recovered from female's purse. The female was taken into custody for CCW.
