


Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Franklin River Dr. (Apartments) for a Domestic, women screaming for help. The male half left the scene in a Black Chrysler 300.

Officers arrived on scene and located female victim. She had been assaulted by her boyfriend and had sustained numerous injuries requiring hospitalization. The victim stated her boyfriend punched her numerous times, knocked her down onto the floor and pistol whipped her with his handgun. He also took victims cell phone and smashed it prior to fleeing the apartments.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and took photos of victim's injuries.

Officers arrived on scene and observed suspect vehicle leaving the parking lot N/B on Evergreen Rd.

The vehicle was stopped and the suspect was detained w/o incident. The subject was asked if he had any weapons on him? He told Officers that it was in the driver's door. Officers recovered a handgun from the driver's door of the vehicle. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was on scene and collected evidence. Officers completed their investigation and the male subject was taken into custody for Domestic F/A.

Officers were dispatched to the Gas Station at Telegraph and Twelve Mile for a possible Felonious Assault. Dispatch advised Officers responding that the R/P arrived at the Gas Station in a Red Ford Mustang and was hiding behind the counter after being followed by subjects in three vehicles who pointed a gun at him.

The three vehicles were: Black Cadillac CTS, a Black Chrysler 300 and a Gray Mountaineer.

The vehicles stopped following R/P when he pulled into the gas station and were last seen in the Mall parking lot adjacent to the gas station.

Officers arrived on scene and none of the vehicles described by R/P were located.

When Officers interviewed R/P it was unclear exactly where the F/A occurred and he couldn't explain why the three cars were following him or why anyone would point a gun at him.

R/P stated that the subject that pointed the gun at him was in the Black Cadillac CTS. (driver)
R/P described the driver and passenger as black males in their early twenties. Both males were wearing surgical masks and R/P was unable to provide any physical description of them other than

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of St. James reference a fight between three females. Upon arrival Officers spoke with the R/P. R/P stated she observed three females fighting in the parking lot, between two Office Buildings.

Officers searched the area and located the three females parked in their vehicle in the parking lot where R/P stated they were fighting. Officers spoke to the three females and it was discovered that two of the girls got into a fight over some guy that they had seen earlier in the evening at a gathering where they had been drinking. Neither female wished to press charges.

During questioning of front right passenger, she was making furtive movements so that Officer couldn't see inside her purse. Officer asked female if she had any weapons on her. She stated no several times and then stated she didn't want to lie and was open carrying a handgun in her purse. The purse was to the left of this female and you could not see that there was a handgun in the purse. Officer asked the female if she had a CPL. She stated no. A handgun was recovered from female's purse. The female was taken into custody for CCW.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.
