



the inside of his jacket. The suspect ran back to

Follow Up Arrest Relating to This Incident:
Officers responded to the area of Twelve Mile
Rd. and Telegraph Rd. for a vehicle wanted
regarding an Armed Robbery that occurred
earlier today in Southfield.
Officer advised that the suspect vehicle a Grey
Ford Fusion was located near a business in the
28000 Block of Telegraph Rd. The vehicle became
occupied and officers attempted to stop it.
The vehicle fled N/B through the parking lot.
A pursuit was initiated after the driver failed to
stop and intentional contact was made ending
the pursuit. The driver fled on foot and was
apprehended. There were two passengers in the
suspect vehicle that refused to get out of the
vehicle. One of the passengers eventually
complied and exited the vehicle. The second
passenger refused to exit the vehicle or show his
hands. He was observed reaching into his
waistband and made furtive movements like he
may be armed. Officers tased this passenger and
pulled him from the vehicle. As they pulled him
from the vehicle a handgun was recovered from
his waistband. He was taken into custody for
CCW & R&O. (No CPL)
The suspect vehicle was a confirmed stolen out
of neighboring jurisdiction. It's believed that the
suspects were involved in numerous Larcenies/

			Robberies involving meeting victims through social media and then taking the items victims were selling.

Victim sat in her vehicle for around five minutes waiting for one of her coworkers. While waiting a male wearing a black ski mask and all black clothing approached her driver's side window from the rear of her vehicle. The male produced a handgun and tapped on the driver's window with it. The male pulled on her door handle two times attempting to open victim's car door and motioned for victim to exit the vehicle. Victim observed her coworker driving by and hit her horn to attract her attention. Victim then put her vehicle into drive and drove away from suspect east through the lot and out onto Telegraph Rd. Victim did not see the suspect after leaving the parking lot and was unsure if he entered a vehicle. Victim described the suspect as a dark- skinned male, tall and skinny. He was wearing all black and had on a black ski mask. He was

	carrying a black backpack and had dark red Beat Headphones on his head. The gun was described as a black handgun. Victims friend was later interviewed and stated she observed the suspect running north through the parking lot. She did not realize what had happened with her friend. She last saw the suspect crossing Farmbrook Rd going N/B adjacent to Telegraph Rd. Officers arrived into the area and observed subject matching the description of suspect on the northeast corner of Telegraph Road and 12 Mile Road. Officers contacted the subject and immediately noticed he was wearing Beats Style Headphones and had a black backpack & a black mask matching the description given by the victim. The subject was handcuffed and detained. Officer began to pat down the male when he observed a bulge on the left side. Officer grabbed the left side of the male's waistband and felt a handgun. Officer immediately retrieved & secured the handgun. It was later discovered that it was a Black BB Gun. The subject was taken into custody for Attempted Car Jacking.

This past week there were six (6) vehicles attacked at Apartment Complex in the 20000 Block of Lahser Rd. The Chevy Malibu's attacked ranged from the year 2015- 2021. It appears that the vehicles were attacked between Tuesday 12/28/2021 11:00am-Wednesday 12/29/2021 4:00pm. Most likely the incidents occurred in the late night or early morning hours. This type of LFA involving Chevy Malibu's have been occurring throughout the city recently.

#### Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. The female was located and advised by Officers that she had been discharged and had to leave the hospital. She still refused to leave and was taken into custody for Trespassing. Later issued and released. Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

### Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

#### How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
