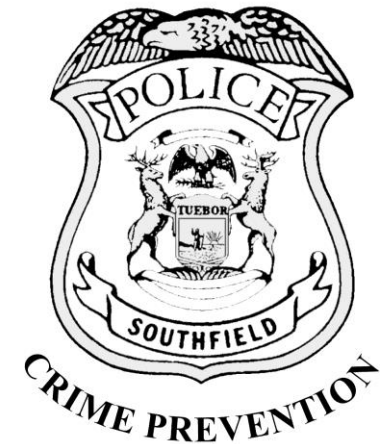

When he got to the back of the vehicle, he was approached by two subjects. They demanded his money. Suspect#1 pointed a handgun at him and Suspect#2 pepper sprayed him in the face. After he got pepper sprayed he went to get back into the cab, but the cab driver began driving away. Victim ran east through the complex to get away from the suspects. The suspects didn't get anything from victim. The driver of the taxi was later interviewed. He pulled away because he saw the suspect with the gun.</p> <p>He immediately called the police.</p> <p>Additional information was there was possibly a Black Lincoln Navigator and a Dark Colored Chevy Silverado involved in the incident.</p>

Officer (SRO) was summoned for assistance at the school, for a Disorderly parent outside the main doors of the building. The parent was attempting to remove her 14- year old daughter from the school. She became upset when the school wouldn't release the student until her information was verified. At the same time, this was happening the student's grandmother called and stated she had legal guardianship over the child and she was otw to the school with paperwork of her guardianship. The grandmother never showed up at the school and the student was eventually released to her mother after student confirmed that it was her mother and she felt safe and wanted to be with her mother.

The grandmother, later came into the front desk of the Police Department with proper paper work of her guardianship over her granddaughter. She advised that the mother was trying to take the child out of state where she lives. The mother and child were later located.

The child was fine and Officers took custody of her.

The mother was advised that she must go through the courts to get custody of her daughter and currently the grandmother has legal guardian rights.

The grandmother didn't wish to prosecute.

**9 Mile Rd./ Newport St.**

A Ford F-150 was pulling a trailer with scrap metal heading West on Nine Mile when the trailer broke free from the truck. The trailer crossed the center line of Nine Mile and struck a vehicle heading East. A metal object from the trailer ejected and hit the victim's vehicle. The victim was taken to the hospital and is in critical condition. The scene was processed by TSB Officers. The victim was later pronounced deceased.

**False Pretenses/ Credit Card Fraud/ Identity Theft/****Obstruct Police- 1- Arrest**

12/06/2021 7:16pm

**28000 Telegraph Rd.****(Dealership)**

On 12/06/2021 at 7:16pm, Officers were dispatched to Car Dealership in the 28000 Block of Telegraph regarding a fraud in progress. Dispatch advised Officers that a B/M subject with a beard, wearing a black shirt and a beanie was presenting someone else's ID, attempt to purchase a vehicle.

Officers arrived on scene, spoke to employees from Dealership and spoke to the suspect. Officers concluded that the suspect in question was not who he had presented himself to be. The suspect was in possession of a fraudulent driver's license and a fraudulent credit card matching the information on the fraudulent driver's license.

The dealership and Officers contacted the person who had his identity fraudulently used and he stated he wished to prosecute. The suspect committed the crime of larceny of a motor vehicle by false pretenses >\$1,000.00 when he used a false identity to defraud the Dealership out of a vehicle by using someone else's information to lease a vehicle.

The suspect additionally was charged with misrepresentation of information (Obstruction) by disguising his identity with the intent to obstruct Officers.

This case was presented to the OCPO and Complaint & Warrant were authorized.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

**F/A Domestic- 1- Arrest**

**(Apartments)**

On 12/07/2021 at 10:28pm Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of Berg Rd. (Apartments) regarding a possible Domestic Assault. Several calls came in reporting that a female could be overheard screaming for help. The female victim also called and reported her boyfriend assaulted he and he left with her vehicle, 2013 Gray Hyundai Sonata

Officers arrived on scene and spoke to female victim.

Victim states she got into an argument with her boyfriend.

The argument escalated to male suspect assaulting & strangling victim several times. Prior to leaving the apartment, suspect took victims cell phone, car and house keys and her 2013 Gray Hyundai Sonata. Victim advised that the suspect has been allowed to drive her vehicle in the past. Victim's mother is the registered owner of the vehicle but victim is the primary driver.

**Note: (Follow up contact and arrest of suspect.)**

The following day 12/08/2021 Officers were dispatched back to the same residence. Victim stated her now ex- boyfriend had returned to the apartment.

Officers contacted the male suspect. He was very irate and refused to speak with Officers about the incident the night prior. Officers established PC to arrest suspect and he was taken into custody processed and lodged w/o incident.



-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

**Special Attention:**

**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

## **Special Attention: Crime Prevention Tip's for the Holidays!**

With the Holidays approaching citizens should be extra careful when shopping. Citizens should never leave anything of value inside the compartment area of their vehicle. If you must leave valuables in the car be sure to put them in the trunk. If you don't have a trunk then I would recommend you take items home.

Women should be extra careful when carrying a purse. Don't ever carry your purse over your shoulder and don't ever leave your purse in a shopping cart unattended. You are an easy target for someone to take your purse or take your wallet from your purse.

I would recommend that citizens not carry a purse; instead they should carry a wallet or something that can be concealed from thieves.
