


Officers located a handgun and suspected marijuana inside the vehicle.

The suspected marijuana was Field Tested by a Southfield Police

Evidence Technician. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

A blood draw was completed at local hospital and the driver was conveyed to Southfield Jail for processing and to be lodged for OWI/ Possession of Marijuana & CCW.
