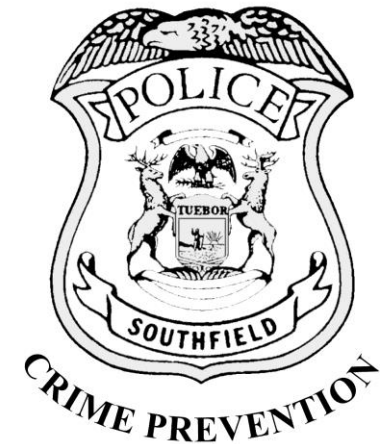

It was unoccupied and was impounded. Investigation is on-going.</p>

TCSU Officers located and arrested person responsible for multiple violent felonies. One of the incidents occurred in the City of Southfield on 12/23/2021. The victim in this incident was Robbed and shot several times while attempting to sell two Play Station 5 Systems. The suspect is believed to be responsible for several similar Robberies/ Larcenies that have occurred in Southfield and other jurisdictions. Investigation is on-going.

Officer was on routine patrol in his fully marked police vehicle in the 23000 block of Greenfield Rd. (Office Building). He was on patrol at this location because of the high volume of crime including several recent Robberies.

While patrolling the lot Officer observed a Gray 2019 Chrysler 300 with no license plate backed into a handicap parking space. The vehicle was running and did not have a visible handicap permit. Officer pulled his patrol vehicle in front of the vehicle to investigate. Officer exited his patrol vehicle and immediately observed two males in the back seat of the Chrysler 300. He observed one of the males climb from the back seat of the vehicle into the driver seat of the Chrysler 300. The suspect vehicle began backing up. Officer got back into his patrol vehicle and activated his emergency overhead lights and positioned his patrol vehicle near the front of the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle then accelerated and rammed into the front of Officer patrol vehicle. The suspect vehicle then reversed striking a handicap parking sign directly behind it and struck the front end of a citizens Gray Lincoln SUV parked directly behind the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle accelerated again ramming into the front end of Officers patrol vehicle. The suspect vehicle feloniously assaulted Officer attempting to force Officers patrol vehicle out of the way so it could flee.

The suspect driving the vehicle continued to reverse and accelerate back and forth into the front of Officers patrol vehicle. The driver of the suspect vehicle was also reaching behind the front passenger seat toward the floor board (Furtive movement) as he was attempting to flee. After failing to move Officers patrol vehicle, both

Officers were dispatched on a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located multiple shell casings and bullet holes in an attached garage. Nobody was injured or hit by the rounds fired. The suspect was already gone.

The Detective Bureau was notified.

The scene was processed & Investigation is on-going.

Suspect:

An unknown person, thin build, approx. 6'-0", wearing dark clothing.

Suspect Vehicle:

Dark colored Tahoe or Escalade, last seen eastbound on Nine Mile Rd.

occupants in the vehicle exited the vehicle and fled on foot. The suspects began running South through the Office Building parking lot. As one of the suspects was running away, both of his boots fell off. This suspect continued running barefoot.

The driver of the suspect vehicle ran east across Greenfield Rd. He fell to the ground at the grass median that separated S/B Greenfield Rd. from 9 Mile Rd. Officers caught up to the suspect in the N/B lanes of Greenfield Rd. and he was taken into custody.

Officers searched the suspect (driver) incident to arrest and located a loaded handgun on his person.

Another Southfield Officer who was with the suspect vehicle located a fully loaded assault rifle on the rear passenger seat floor board of the suspect vehicle. This is where the driver was reaching as he was attempting to flee by ramming Officers patrol vehicle.

Three cell phones were recovered from the vehicle.

The suspects boots that fell off while fleeing were also recovered.

Additional Officers on-scene determined that the second suspect ran into the East entrance of the nearby Office Building.

Officers shut down all access to the building and formed a perimeter around the building. Several Officers began searching the building floor by floor. Officers located suspect on the 5th floor that was mostly vacant space or under construction. The suspect was taken into custody w/o incident. The suspect didn't have any shoes on! Both suspects were taken into custody and conveyed to the Southfield Jail for processing and lodging.

The victim was walking in the parking lot when an unknown male approached him and started shooting. The suspect fled the scene in a Black Cadillac XT5 or XT6. The victim was taken to an area hospital and is listed in critical condition. The Detective Bureau was notified and responded. The scene was processed. Investigation is on-going.

Officers responded to the 21000 Block of W Ten Mile Rd. for a report of an LFA that just occurred. Dispatch advised that Security located subjects that were underneath a vehicle who had since fled. Security followed the suspect vehicle to the 22000 Block of Ten Mile where the vehicle became disabled and two b/m suspects fled on foot. Officers located one of the suspects walking on Ten Mile Rd. close to where the vehicle was abandoned. Officers stopped the suspect and while speaking to him other Officers were reviewing surveillance video from the business where the suspect vehicle was dumped. Video shows the suspects exiting the minivan, the passenger of the vehicle matching exactly to the suspect that was Officers had stopped. He was taken into custody for Attempt Larceny of Catalytic Converter.

The Mercedes Benz (attacked vehicle) was locked up and the catalytic convertor was halfway cut off. A catalytic convertor from an unknown vehicle and Sawzall blades were recovered from the suspect's vehicle. The second suspect was not located.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also

very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
