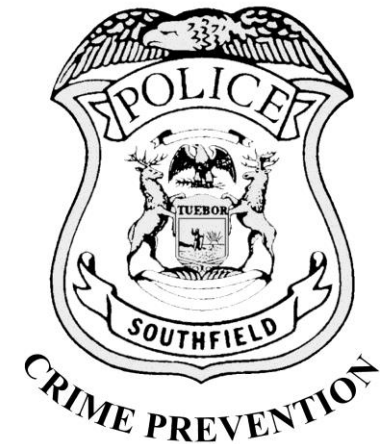
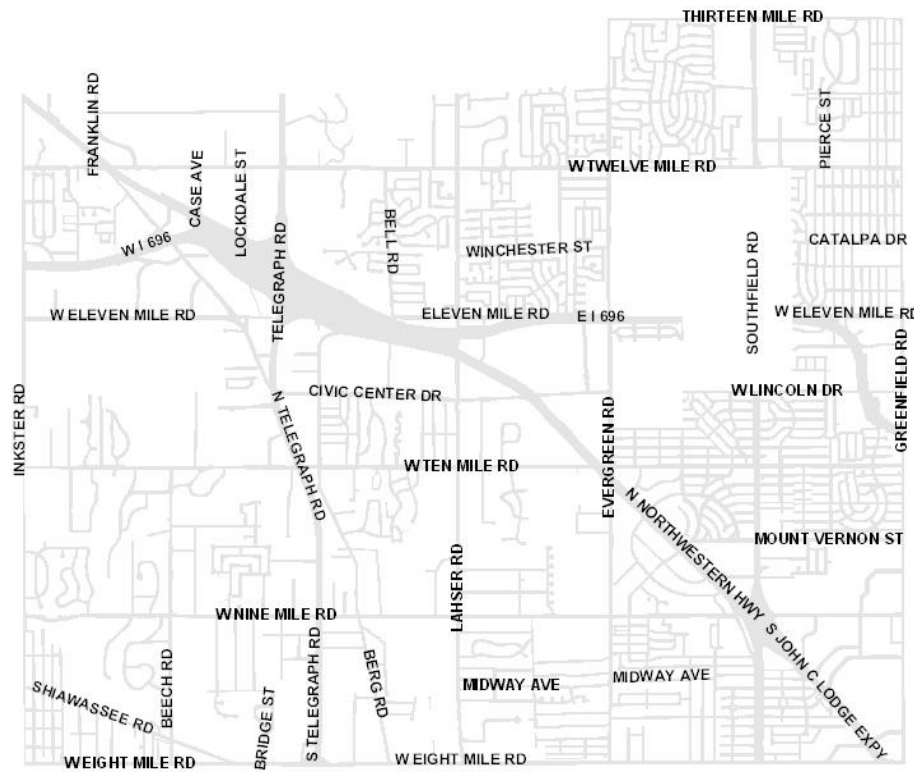

Officers arrived on scene and met with the male half (suspect) who was bleeding from the hand. Officer met with the female half and two other female witnesses. The witnesses followed victim home after an incident at her work in Detroit. The witnesses state that the male half suspect kicked in the door to victim's residence and assaulted her. Officers ran suspect and he had a 2- Warrants out of Southfield that were confirmed. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and took photos of damages and injuries. The male suspect was taken into custody for Domestic Violence and Home Invasion.

Be on the Look Out Highlights:	Arrests by SPD Officers:
<p>Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!) - If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage. - Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock. -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. TCSU Officers conducted surveillance on a male subject who had fled from a traffic stop on 01/13/2020. After the suspect fled from Officer he positively identified the driver of the vehicle through the vehicles registration. It was discovered that suspect was currently on parole for armed robbery, carrying concealed weapons, and resisting and obstructing police out of MDOC. He is also a suspect in a shooting in Detroit from 2018 and he was an uncooperative victim in a shooting in Southfield in August of 2019.

TCSU Officers located suspect and he was taken into custody w/o incident. His Parole Agent was also notified and he will most likely be charged with Violating his Parole.
