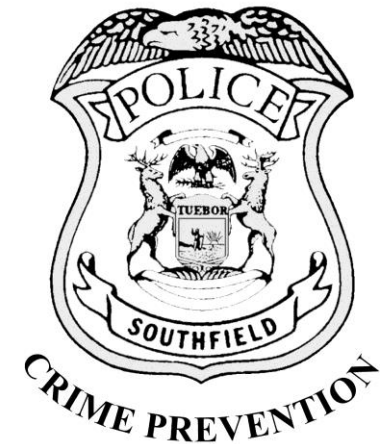
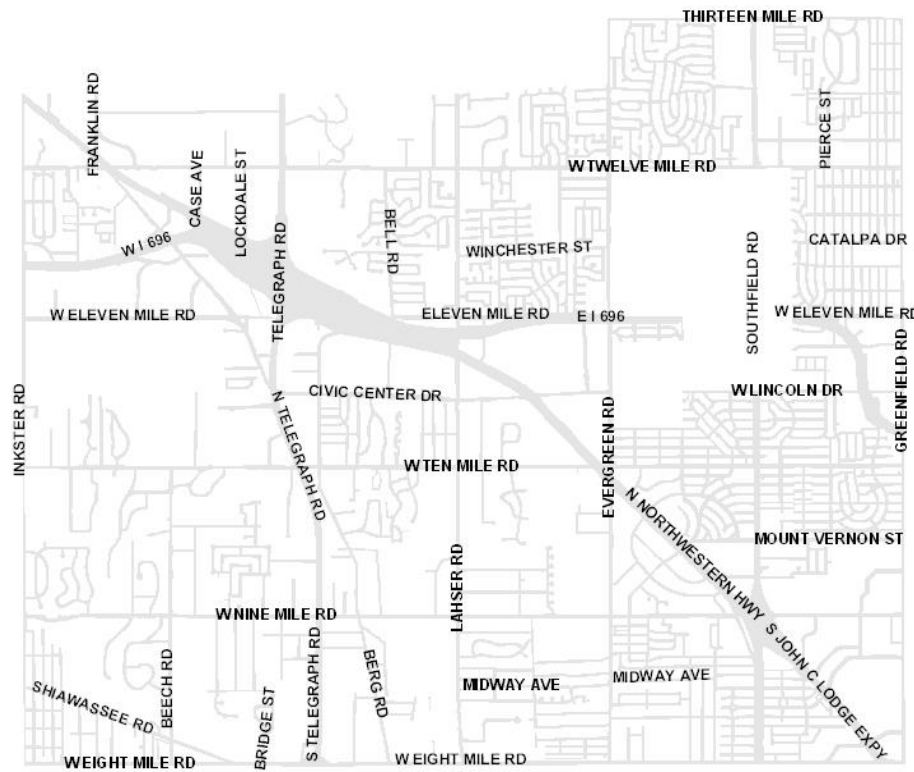

R/P advises her ex-boyfriend had broken into her apartment and an assault occurred. Officers have been out to this location recently for same thing. The suspect left prior to Officers arrival.</p> <p>Officer located the suspect in his Gold Chevy Impala S/B on Telegraph & 8 Mile Rd. The vehicle was stopped w/o incident.</p> <p>The driver was identified as the suspect in incident. He was found to be driving with a Suspended Driver's License.</p> <p>Officers on scene spoke to victim. Victim advises her ex-boyfriend was upset because of what he found on her cell phone. The two got into a verbal argument that escalated to her being assaulted. During the incident victims phone was damaged and the suspect left the apartment. Suspect returned to apartment and forced entry into the apartment to get his keys and fled the area.</p>

			<p>A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was on-scene and took photos of the damaged door, victims injuries and the damaged cell phone. The suspect was arrested for DWLS/ Domestic Assault/ Home Invasion/ Obstruct Police & MDOP.</p> <p>Note: After suspect was transported to the jail he became disorderly and attempted to assault jail personnel. Officers assisted jail personnel and placed suspect into a jail cell.</p>
01/21/2020 5:40pm	28000 Thornapple Dr. (Apartments)	Apartment door was forced open.	<p>R/P advises that he was trying to get his ex-girlfriend to come over and collect some of the things she had left behind. Previous attempts she didn't show up. On January 21, 2020 @ 5:45pm victim came home and found her apartment door had been forced open and several items were missing.</p> <p>Victim texted his ex-girlfriend and asked her why she broke into his apartment. She responded back she didn't know that he had changed the locks and she thought that the door was just stuck.</p>

01/23/2020 2:31pm	20000 Westhampton	Entry through unlocked rear garage window.	<p>Officer were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Westhampton for a B&E Alarm. Officers arrived on scene and found good Home Invasion. Entry was through rear unlocked garage window. Several items were taken from the residence.</p> <p>The homeowner advised she received a camera motion alert on her phone showing the suspect walking up the driveway and checking the front door around 2:19pm.</p> <p>At 2:21pm, Homeowner received another camera motion alert at the rear door showing the same suspect checking the back door and looking in the window. Victim did not recognize the suspect. Officers arrived on scene and discovered good Home Invasion.</p> <p>Suspect Description: B/M, dark complexion, thin build mid 20's about 6'0"-6'2". Last seen wearing a Blue Detroit Pistons Jacket with "PISTONS" written in red on the back, light blue jeans, and a black beanie.</p>

The video also shows a possible suspect vehicle (Dark Color Late Model Chevrolet Impala) following the suspect to the vehicle prior to the vehicle being stolen. Note: This is the third vehicle stolen from this location. The vehicle was recovered on 01/21/2020 at approx. 3:12pm. It was recovered in Detroit. The vehicle was completely stripped and there was ignition damage.

Sometime between 9:00pm- and the following morning at 9:00am someone stole the vehicle. The vehicle was recovered in the 14000 Block of Grandville in Detroit. No arrests made. The plate is with the vehicle and the VIN is intact. Vehicle had rear bumper push marks, the trunk lid was held by string, and it was missing the engine, transmission, radiator, and fuses.

Nine Mile Rd. Security Officer, Maintenance Worker, and Building Engineer from location all went up to the 12th Floor after being notified of a Larceny in Suite & several Fire Alarms were activated. They contacted a subject in the stairway on the 12th floor. He was carrying a golf club and raised it at the maintenance worker when he approached him. The maintenance worker stated he was in fear of being hit with the golf club. At this point the Security Officer took the suspect down and tackled him to prevent him from hitting maintenance worker. All three subjects then detained subject in the stairwell until Officers arrived. Investigation revealed that the suspect had activated several extinguishers on several different floors. It was also determined that suspect took the Detroit Lion's Jersey, Helmet, Golf Club, and Golf Balls from a suite on the 12th floor. The stolen items were all recovered and returned to business. Suspect used the golf club to break multiple items, including computer monitors, a laptop, copy machine, windows, doors, & multiple sports memorabilia. Officer arrived on scene and spoke to employee.</p> <p>R/P (victim) states around 7:30pm a B/M entered the store and produced a pistol from his waistband. The male pointed the pistol at R/P and demanded all the money in the cash register. While R/P was gathering up the money a customer entered the store. While the suspect was looking away, R/P dove behind the counter. The suspect ran out of the store and R/P heard one loud Bang like a gun going off.</p> <p>The suspect did not get any money or merchandise during the robbery.</p> <p>The patron that walked into the store stated he heard the commotion by the counter and then heard what sounded like a gun shot by the entrance to business.</p> <p>The wife of patron who was waiting in their car observed a male wearing dark clothing run out of the store and around two parked cars. After suspect ran around the cars she observed the male turn and fire a gun towards the front doors. The suspect fled on foot N/B on Red River.</p> <p>Surveillance video shows a Black 4-dr. vehicle (suspect vehicle) parked on Jeanette St. just east of Red River. The suspect can be seen walking from the vehicle into the store at approx. 7:28pm. At 7:29pm the suspect is viewed fleeing the store, running around two cars and firing his</p>
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			<p>gun at the front doors to business. The suspect is then seen getting into his vehicle and fleeing the area. The suspect is a B/M early 20's, 5'8" 130-150 lbs., no facial hair and brown eyes. The suspect does have a large tattoo on his right hand. The suspect was wearing a dark blue hoodie with the hood up, dark colored jeans & black shoes. 2- Southfield Police Evidence Technicians processed the scene, took photos and collected evidence.</p>

R/P advised dispatch that there were multiple subjects shooting at him and he was on foot North of business. The victim was located at a nearby Gas Station. He advised Officers that he was armed with a handgun. The handgun was secured by Officers w/o incident. Victim went on to tell Officers that he was physically assaulted by multiple subjects (unknown description) inside the business and was hit in the head at least twice by a closed fist. (Visible blood coming out of the victim's nose). Victim went to his vehicle and grabbed his firearm. The unknown subjects exited the bar and started shooting at him. Victim shot back at the subjects and fled the area on foot. He doesn't believe that he hit any of the subjects when he shot at them. Evidence suggested that several shots were fired. Several vehicles including victim's vehicle were hit with spent rounds. Businesses were also hit with spent rounds and a window was broken out. No cooperation from anyone.
