



He drove through the parking lot and threw victims purse out the window and took off. The suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

Officer was on routine patrol when observing vehicle, 2009 Jeep Grand Cherokee with inoperative tail lights. Registration on vehicle came back with no Insurance. After the vehicle was stopped the driver immediately exited his vehicle and started walking back towards Officers patrol vehicle. He was ordered to return to his vehicle and the driver complied.

(Citizens that are stopped by the Police should always remain in their vehicle and wait for Officer(s) to contact them.)

After contact was made with the driver and asking for his information he was shaking and seemed very nervous. The vehicle was also occupied by female passenger. During the traffic stop both occupants in the vehicle gave Officer permission to search the vehicle. Prior to searching the vehicle, it was discovered that the driver had an Expired Driver's License and several warrants out of Detroit. Additional Officers arrived on scene to assist Officer in his investigation. Prior to searching the vehicle, the female passenger made admissions that there may be a crack pipe and some small baggies with cocaine residue inside her purse. When both occupants were removed from the vehicle Officers immediately noticed a baggie containing what appeared to be rock cocaine on the driver seat where the driver was seated. Officers recovered the suspected cocaine. During the search of the vehicle Officers also recovered a crack pipe and several small baggies containing white powdery substance from female's purse.
