Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizens can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

After contact was made with the occupants it was discovered that the driver didn’t have a Driver’s License and the other occupants stated they didn’t have any Identification on their person.

The driver was asked to step out of the vehicle, when he did, a white pill fell on the ground. The driver told Officers that it was an opiate and he didn’t have a prescription for it.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with

The driver gave Officer consent to search the vehicle. During the search of the vehicle Officers located additional suspected narcotics, several hypodermic needles and a crack pipe. The driver was taken into custody for DWLS & VCSA. The right front passenger was also taken into custody for VCSA. The right rear passenger was identified after he provided an alias name. He had a 3rd Circuit Court Warrant for Dangerous Drugs. He was arrested for Misrepresentation. The fourth passenger was clear Lein and released at the scene. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and collected evidence.
