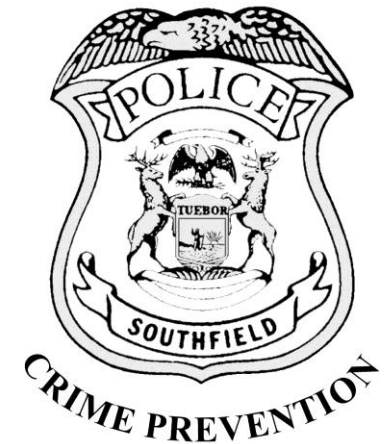

(Multi Office Building)	Unknown if anything was taken.	<p>On 7/23/2021 Officers were patrolling the area of Greenfield & Providence Dr. when Officers were flagged down by multiple citizens stating there were people behind the 23000 Block of Greenfield Rd. (Office Building) shooting at each other. According to multiple citizens, a white sedan was involved. This information was put out over the radio to other Officers.</p> <p>Officers arrived in the area. They located a witness that stated he heard gunshots coming from the parking lot.</p> <p>He looked out his window and saw multiple black males running in different directions. He stated some of the subjects entered a White SUV, possibly a Lincoln Aviator, that fled the scene in an unknown direction. He also saw what he thought was a White Cadillac CTS, that he believes was associated with the shooting.</p> <p>He stated he witnessed a black male "limping" as he was running to the White Cadillac CTS. He entered the CTS which fled E/B Nine Mile, then S/B Greenfield.</p> <p>The White Cadillac CTS appeared to have accident damage on the driver side of the front bumper.</p> <p>Several spent shell casings were recovered in the parking lot. Two vehicles unrelated to incident were damaged and two bullets struck the</p>

			building and entered one of the suites. Nobody was injured. Hospitals were checked, no shooting victims were located. Investigation is on-going.

<p>Special Attention: Threat to Burn/ Mental Health Commitment 07/23/2021 12:20pm 21000 Block of Evergreen Rd. Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of Evergreen Rd. for a possible Arson. R/P advises suspect was threatening to burn down his mother's house, which he has tried before. Suspect had walked to the gas station filled up a can with gas and was walking back to his house. Officers arrived on scene and observed suspect standing at the south side door of the residence. On the ground, next to him was a gas can that appeared to be empty. The suspect was given commands to walk out to Officers, which he complied. Suspect was visibly wet, and had a strong odor of gas coming from him. Officers completed their investigation and a decision was made for the safety of everyone to take the suspect into Protected Custody. Southfield PD was notified that a potential Bomb Threat was made towards school in the 24000 Block of Lahser Rd. The threat stated that there were bombs being placed around the school and that a male and female were involved. Southfield Officers responded as well as numerous Explosive Detecting Canine Units from the Oakland County area. The investigations Division was notified and are working to identify the suspects involved. Explosive Detecting Canines swept the location and found nothing suspicious. Investigation is on-going.

W Twelve Mile Rd. & Telegraph Rd

On 07/19/2021 at approx. 7:41pm, multiple Southfield Officers were dispatched to business located in the 24000 Block of W 12 Mile Rd. for reports of an armed subject. The R/P advised dispatch that a heavy-set B/M, wearing all black, pulled out a gun and put a clip in it. He was with a second unknown B/M subject.

Officers arrived on scene and located the two subjects matching the description in the parking lot, west of the business. Officers ordered the males to get on the ground. The B/M, suspected of having the handgun was detained & handcuffs.

During the pat down Officers recovered a handgun and magazine on this person. R/P stated he was walking outside to have a smoke and saw suspect walking around carrying a handgun. He states an unknown female in a Black Chrysler 300 asked subject what he was doing, to which he replied "I'm gonna shoot this M.F. out". Officers also reviewed CCTV video showing suspect in the parking lot and retrieving a handgun from a Gold Buick Lacrosse and place it in his pocket. The suspect did not have a CPL and was taken into custody for CCW.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Possess/ Receive Stolen Vehicle- 2- Arrests

27000 Block of Northwestern Hwy

On 07/22/2021, Officers were dispatched to the area of S/B Telegraph Rd. near Ten Mile Rd. for a possible stolen vehicle that was mobile. Dispatch advised that the caller was actively tracking a stolen 2020 Cadillac XT6, black in color. The vehicle was reported stolen on: 07/22/2021 from Davison PD (Genesee County, MI). The vehicle was reported stolen from a dealership.

Further direction from caller, the vehicle was pinging near the 21000 Block of Fairway. Officers located the vehicle backed into the driveway at this location. The vehicle was occupied by four subjects. Officers activated their overheads and placed their patrol vehicles around the front of the stolen vehicle to block it from leaving. Additional Officers and Oakland County Auto Theft Officers also arrived on scene and were assisting. The occupants in the vehicle were compliant, removed from the vehicle and secured.

Southfield Dispatch confirmed the vehicle was stolen out of Davison PD. Upon searching the vehicle, Officers recovered the key fob for the vehicle in a jacket pocket inside the vehicle.

Officers from the Oakland County Auto Theft Task Force took over the investigation and all four occupants were arrested:

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

(Gas Station)

On 07/25/2021 at 6:02pm Officers were patrolling near Ten Mile Rd. and Evergreen Rd. Officers conducted a license plate search in LEIN of a White Dodge Durango with two black racing stripes parked by a gas pump in Gas Station in the 25000 Block of Evergreen Rd.

The vehicle returned in LEIN as stolen out of Redford Twp. Moments later, the White Durango exited the parking lot through the South exit of the gas station and proceeded onto W/B Ten Mile Rd.

Officers followed the suspect vehicle and it began to accelerate at a high a high rate of speed travelling N/B on the Northwestern Service Dr. from Ten Mile Rd. Officers activated their emergency overhead lights and siren and advised dispatch of vehicle pursuit with the suspect vehicle.

The suspect vehicle fled into Lathrup Village where the pursuit ended at the dead end of S. Bloomfield Dr. The suspect vehicle crashed into a wooden fence at the end of the street. The driver exited the vehicle and actively fled officers on foot going W/B through the backyards.

Officers pursued the driver on foot. The front seat and rear seat passengers then began to open their doors and exit the vehicle. Additional Officers arrived on scene and ordered both passengers to the ground to which they complied.

After a brief foot pursuit with the driver, Officers apprehend the suspect. He was taken into custody for Fleeing & Eluding/ R&C Motor Vehicle/ R&O & Expired License.

The two passengers were later identified and RPI'd.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
