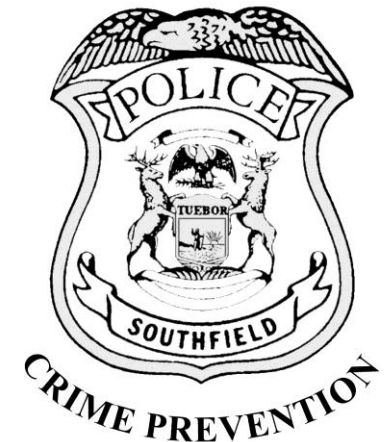
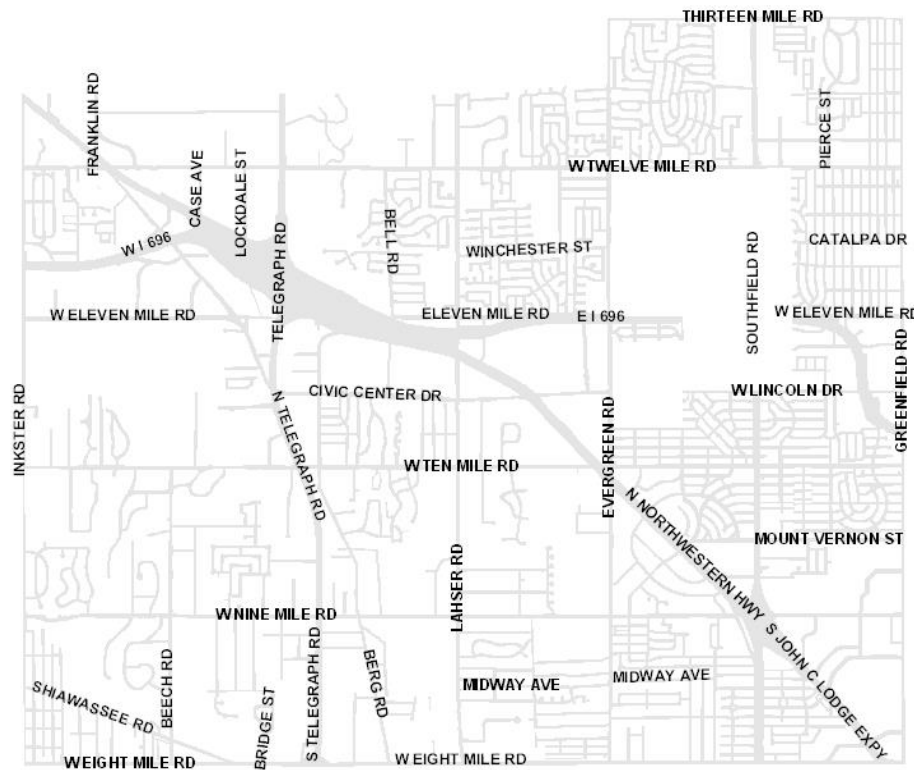

**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

**(Apartments)**

On 7/23/2019 Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Franklin Rd. for reports of a female walking around barely clothed and bleeding. They got a second call saying the female got in a fight with her friend.

Officers arrived on scene and located a female matching the description banging on the door of apartment inside the building. She appeared disheveled. Clothes were barely hanging on. She had several obvious injuries. She agreed to come out and speak to Officers. Victim stated there was a male inside the apartment that held her hostage, stole her money, and she was sexually assaulted. Additional units and supervisors arrived on scene and a perimeter was set up around the apartment building. Numerous attempts were made to try and contact the residents. The residents eventually came out of the apartment.

After interviewing everyone, one 19- year old male was taken into custody for CSC I.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. **Possession of Heroin- 1- Arrest**

**Evergreen Rd. & Beechhaven**

On 07/27/2019, Officers were dispatched to the area of Evergreen and Twelve Mile for a subject in a white van, possibly a subject that was reported missing.

Officers located the vehicle and subject who was in the driver's seat of the vehicle. He was sweating, had constricted pupils, was speaking irrationally, and was using animated hand motions.

After the driver exited the vehicle Officers observed a large sum of money on the front seat and what appeared to be drug folds on the floor board directly in front of the driver's seat. There was a brown powdery substance inside the paper folds consistent with Heroin. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected substance. It tested positive for possible presence of Heroin. The subject was taken into custody for Possession of Heroin.

## Domestic F/A & CCW-

29000 Block of Pointe O Woods

### (Apartments)

On 07/28/2019, Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Pointe O Woods Pl. on report of an F/A Domestic involving a gun. Officers arrived on scene as dispatch updated that the female half (suspect) was leaving the scene in a Dark Malibu. Officers located and stopped the vehicle as it exited Pointe O Woods Pl. onto W Twelve Mile Rd.

After securing the suspect Officers contacted the male victim and interviewed him. The victim stated that his wife caught him cheating on her and she was in the process of getting some of her belongings and moving out. At some point during this process she grabbed a baseball bat and hit victim with it several times. The female suspect then went and got her handgun, pointed it at victim and threatened to shoot him.

During the stop of suspect Officers recovered a handgun.

The female suspect doesn't have a CPL and was taken into custody for Domestic F/A & CCW.
