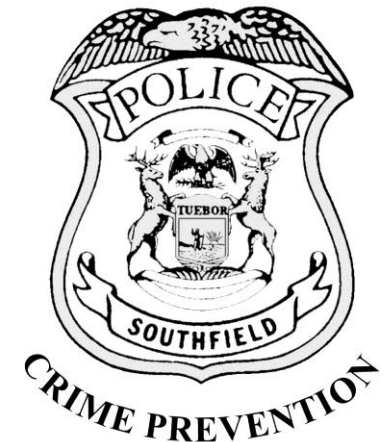

**Commercial Burglaries:**

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
07/31/2019 4:46am	29000 Telegraph Rd. (Commercial- Smoothie Cafe)	Glass door near drive-thru was broken out.	Officers responded to alarm at business at 4:47am. Upon arrival Officers discovered good B&E. The glass door near the drive-thru was broken out. It appears that all three cash drawers had been gone through. Video surveillance shows a Tan GMC Yukon or Suburban with aftermarket Chrome Rims (20" to 24"), and tinted windows pull up to the drive-thru door. One unknown male exited the driver's seat wearing a black zip-up hoodie with the hood up and his face covered and wearing black pants. The male attempted to pry the door with a crow bar and was unsuccessful and smashed the glass with the crow bar and unlocked the door. The male ran in and attempted to open the safe but was unsuccessful. The male proceeded to check the cash registers but realized they were empty. The male again attempted to gain entry to the safe by prying it open but was unsuccessful. The male took two tablets, exited the store, entered his vehicle, and left the business.

R/P states he was conducting an inspection of the facility and found someone had pried open a metal sided wall, entered the enclosed electrical substation and cut a security alarm cable. A gate mechanism was also damaged from trying to open the large gate. Nothing appears to be missing. It may have been scrappers who found nothing to take.

On Friday, August 02, 2019 at approximately 7:38pm, Officers responded to the 19000 block of Melrose on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, Officers located a 19-year-old male victim in the driveway of a residence. The victim was transported to an area hospital by the Southfield Fire Department. A second victim was located near the residence and appeared to be suffering from a gunshot wound as well. He was treated at the scene.

A 19-year male was later identified as the shooter and was taken into custody.

## **Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**

### **How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
