On 07/10/2021, at approx.10:58pm, R/P (victim) came in to the station to file a police report. R/P stated she was robbed near Southfield Service Dr. and Cornell St. at approx. 2:30am. Victim was in town visiting her boyfriend. They had just left a Nightclub in Detroit and got into an argument. Her boyfriend made her get out of the car at Cornell & Southfield Rd. He then took off and left her. Victim flagged down an unknown Black SUV for help that was occupied by three unknown black males. The front passenger asked R/P if she needed help. R/P said yes. Once she began walking towards the car, the back passenger exited the vehicle and punched her in the face three times. The unknown B/M back passenger then grabbed her purse and attempted to pull it away from her. The front seat passenger then knocked her to the ground and they took her purse which had her cell phone and numerous other items. Victim sat on the side of the road for approx. an hour until she flagged down a good Samaritan for help. Victim later, pinged her phone and found it in a trash can at an unknown gas station in Detroit.

**Special Attention:**

**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officers responded to the 29000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (Gas Station) on a report of a suspicious vehicle.

R/P called and stated there is a Silver Jeep Commander with an improper plate. The vehicle was occupied by 3- W/M's and it looked like they were using drugs. They had a tourniquet on and were shooting up with needles.

Officers arrived on scene, located the vehicle still at the gas pumps.

3- W/M's were detained and investigation ensued.

Two of the subjects were found to be in Possession of Heroin & Methamphetamine. They were both taken into custody, transported and lodged at the Southfield Jail.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field tested samples of the suspected substances. They tested positive for possible presence of Heroin & Methamphetamine.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Officer stopped vehicle for Traffic Violations.

After contact was made with the driver he seemed very nervous and was shaking. Officer asked the driver if there were any drugs in the car or anything illegal. The driver stated there was some weed in the car. During questioning of the driver Officer noticed a bottle of pills in plain view under the radio that appeared to have multicolored pills inside consistent with ecstasy. The driver stated he didn't know what the pills were and gave them to Officer.

Officers K-9 conducted a sweep of the vehicle and alerted in the area where the bottle of pills we're located.

The pills were later Field Tested by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician. It tested positive for possible presence of Ecstasy.

The driver was taken into custody for Possession of Ecstasy.

Note: The female passenger in the vehicle had a confirmed Controlled Substance Warrant out of Canton PD. A second Officer took custody of the female and met Canton PD and turned the female over to them.

Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
