


On 7/2/2020 Officers were dispatched to Maryland and Stratford for reports of shots fired. Several calls stated a light skin, tall black male wearing a grey shirt was shooting in the air. Officers located a male matching the description in the area and ordered the male to the ground. The male complied and was detained while Officers investigated further.

On 07/06/2020, 2- Southfield Officers were dispatched to Hotel, located in the 23000 Block of Telegraph Rd for an overdose. (Heroin)

The first Officer that arrived on scene located the unresponsive subject and administered his department issued can of Narcan into subject's nostril and began giving chest compressions. A second Officer arrived on scene and provided his department issued Narcan and that was administered to subject as well.

Victim was now starting to breath and had a pulse. After administering Narcan, Officer continued to administer a sternum-rub to subject to assist him in regaining consciousness.

Southfield Fire Paramedics arrived on scene and took over treatment of subject and transported him to the hospital. The subject was still unconscious but had normal breathing prior to transport. The subject was eventually revived.
