The suspect contacted him and was interested in buying the bike.</p> <p>Victim brought the bike to the 20000 Block of Westhaven (abandoned home) where he observed subject getting mail out of the mailbox. He allowed the subject to test drive the motorcycle and the subject never returned with the bike.</p> <p>The suspect was last seen near 8 Mile Rd & Lahser Rd. The suspect has used this M.O. in the past to steal Dirt Bikes and ATV's in this area. The suspect uses the abandoned home and makes it appear that he lives there by getting mail out of the mailbox when the seller(s) arrive. The child was transported to the Hospital where he was pronounced deceased. Several Southfield Police Officers, Evidence Technicians and Detectives were on scene investigating. The incident is under investigation.</p>	<p>Possession or Use of Firearm While Under Influence of Liquor or Drugs- 1- Arrest 07/02/2020 8:16pm Maryland St. & Stratford Dr. On 7/2/2020 Officers were dispatched to Maryland and Stratford for reports of shots fired. Several calls stated a light skin, tall black male wearing a grey shirt was shooting in the air. He arrived in a Black Caravan in front of residence in the 16000 Block of Stratford. Witnesses stated they saw something small in the subject's hand and heard two "small noises". Officers located a male matching the description in the area and ordered the male to the ground. The male complied and was detained while Officers investigated further. Officers investigating, recovered a spent shell casing and recovered a hand gun in the bushes where suspect was observed. The suspect was highly intoxicated and was initially taken into custody for Possession of a Firearm While Intoxicated. On 07/06/2020, 2- Southfield Officers were dispatched to Hotel, located in the 23000 Block of Telegraph Rd for an overdose. (Heroin)

The first Officer that arrived on scene located the unresponsive subject and administered his department issued can of Narcan into subject's nostril and began giving chest compressions. A second Officer arrived on scene and provided his department issued Narcan and that was administered to subject as well.

Victim was now starting to breath and had a pulse. After administering Narcan, Officer continued to administer a sternum-rub to subject to assist him in regaining consciousness.

Southfield Fire Paramedics arrived on scene and took over treatment of subject and transported him to the hospital. The subject was still unconscious but had normal breathing prior to transport. The subject was eventually revived.

Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation. Child Protective Services was notified and the child was tot the Grandmother.
