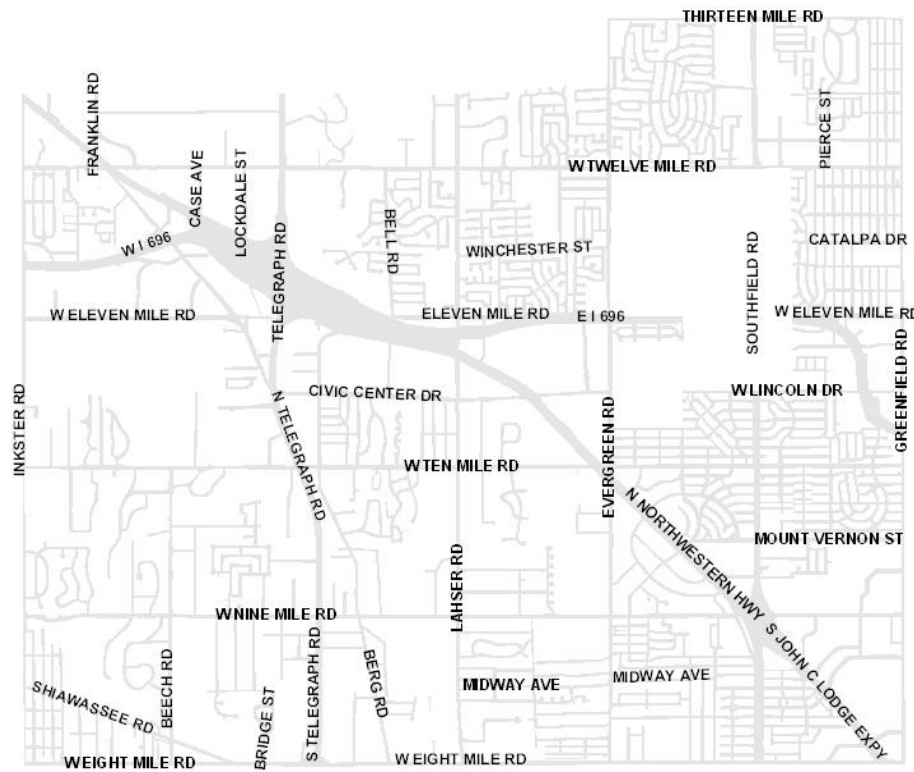

R/P states she has lived in her apartment since April of last year. Her husband has never lived in the apartment with her and their kids. They have been going through the start of a divorce and she suspects her husband entered her apartment and took some of her things. While Officers were at victim's apartment the R/P called her husband to ask him why he took her stuff. He replied that her stuff is at his home. She asked him why he took it and he stated because you need to come back to our house. On (Tuesday) 03/17/2020 the suspect called R/P and stated that he put her things back on her porch. The R/P still wants to press charges for him entering her Apartment and taking her items. Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

Suspect arrived in a Granite Colored Dodge Charger with two other females. Suspect came into Dealership with an unknown B/F and test drove a Jeep Compass. After the first test drive, the unknown B/F left and suspect went to the bathroom. R/P went and grabbed the second vehicle for test drive and waited in the front. When suspect came outside, R/P got out of the driver seat and before he could get back in suspect took off with the vehicle without Key Fob. R/P stated suspect had painted nails and said to him he was currently transitioning from a male to female.</p> <p>Note: Another Southfield Officer believes he may have seen the stolen vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed s/b on Lahser near 9 Mile Rd. prior to the run coming out. Officer attempted to locate the vehicle but was unsuccessful. It was reported that the suspect had exposed himself and threatened staff. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the suspect. He was agitated and Officers couldn't comprehend what he was saying. Officers contacted the suspects son who advised Officers that his father has a mental health condition and has not been on his medication for over 2 months.</p> <p>Officers made the decision to take the suspect into protective custody and to have the suspect committed for evaluation. While speaking with the suspect he presented two keys for his apartment. One of the keys matched the master key that was taken from the manager's office.</p>

			<p>The suspect made admissions that he took it. The suspect was transported to the hospital for evaluation. He was released pending further investigation for the Larceny.</p>

The male suspect had left prior to Officers arrival. Officers were informed that victim had left the apartment a few days ago after an argument with her boyfriend. Victim arrived back home on today's date and her boyfriend wasn't present. Later in the night she received a text from her boyfriend to let him in. Victim went to the door and let him in.</p> <p>Suspect immediately grabbed victim and assaulted her several times. After assaulting her suspect left the apartment.</p> <p>A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the scene and took photos of victim's injuries. Shortly after Officers cleared the scene, the suspect returned to the location and forced his way into the apartment.</p> <p>Officers responded back to the apartment, observing the front door forced open, Officers entered finding victim locked in the bathroom, and suspect was gone.</p> <p>Victim stated after Officers left she locked the door with the deadbolt and placed a chair under the doorknob for added security. A short time later, victim heard her boyfriend at the door and he forced entry into the apartment.</p> <p>Victim barricaded herself in the bathroom. The suspect attempted to get into the bathroom by</p>

Threats/ Commitment:</p> <p>03/20/2020 3:13am 27000 Northwestern Hwy (Hotel)</p> <p>On 03/20/2020 at 3:13am, Officers responded to the 27000 Block of Northwestern Service Dr. (Hotel). Dispatch advised the manager of Hotel was reporting a B/M wearing a black jacket, hitting the door and trying to get in. The subject was yelling he was going to kill everyone.</p> <p>Officer, arrived on scene and observed suspect walking S/B on Telegraph south of the 696 over pass. Suspect seemed highly agitated. He was yelling about god, religion, and threatening to kill everyone. He was sweating profusely, and clinching his fist. Officer attempted to get suspects attention and verbally identified himself as the Police, and that he was there to help him, and asked him to stop walking.</p> <p>The suspect began running s/b on Telegraph Rd. until additional Officers caught up to suspect and attempted to detain him. During the attempt by Officers to detain subject, Officer was assaulted and the suspect continued running s/b on Telegraph Rd. Additional Officers arrived on scene, caught up to suspect and took him into custody for A&B on Police Officer. The suspect was taken to Hospital where he was secured in restraints by Hospital Security.

Officers completed Petition to have suspect committed for evaluation.

Officers on scene at Hotel spoke to the R/P. The R/P stated that the suspect came into the lobby and started yelling that he was sent by god to kill him and whoever he calls. The R/P fearing for his safety, fled from the lobby and went out to his car and called the Police.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the scene and took photos of damage in suspects hotel room and a broken window in the lobby caused by the suspect.

Suspect was RPI'd on the A&B Police Officer & MDOP to Hotel Property.

Evergreen Rd. & W Eight Mile Rd.

Officers responded to accident that occurred on Evergreen Rd. north of Eight Mile Rd. Officer on scene reported that the driver of one of the vehicles took off on foot with a female passenger.

A witness stated the driver and passenger ran south on Vaughan St. into Detroit.

Officers were conducting an area check and observed a B/M matching the description of male suspect wearing a black and white track suit walking s/b on Vaughan St. just south of Fargo St. When the subject saw Officers Patrol Vehicle approaching, he fled on foot w/b through the backyards in the 19000 Block of Vaughan St.

Officers gave chase and caught up to suspect after he had jumped several fences. He was taken into custody.

The male suspect was seen exiting the driver's seat at the scene of the accident by an eyewitness. He does not have a valid driver's license; his license is currently suspended and he has 4 previous DWLS convictions. Officers brought up the registered owner of vehicle involved in accident photo and it matched that of the male suspect.

During Officers investigation, they detected the smell of intoxicants coming from the suspect, his eyes were blood shot and his speech was slurred. The driver was investigated for OWI and a search warrant was obtained and executed for a blood draw at Hospital. Possible OWI charges as well.

24000 W Twelve Mile Rd.

(Restaurant)

On 03/21/2020 at approx. 11:03am Officers were dispatched to the 24000 Block of W Twelve Mile (Restaurant) for an assault that just occurred.

R/P (Manager) advises one of their managers was just terminated. This manager (suspect) became very upset and slammed the business phone on the counter, and then threw it on the floor, breaking it. This same manager then grabbed R/P by her neck and was about to choke her, but another employee stepped in between them and pulled her away. The assault did leave scratches on her neck.

R/P attempted to call 911 on her cell phone, but suspect snatched her phone from her and threw it on the floor cracking the screen.

A SPD Evidence Technician responded to the scene and took photos of victim's injuries and damage to her cell phone. The suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.

Trespassing- 1- Arrest

28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy.

(Hotel)

On 03/21/2020, Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy. (Hotel) for a room eviction.

Officers arrived on scene and were in the lobby with the manager and the subject being evicted. The subject being evicted was yelling at the manager and creating a scene in front of other patrons. He was advised on trespassing by the manager in front of Officers.

The subject walked out of the hotel and into the parking lot, but immediately turned around and walked back inside the lobby.

Officers advised subject if he did not leave immediately he would be placed under arrest for Trespassing. The subject refused to leave and was taken into custody for Trespassing w/o incident.

Note: After placing the suspect into the rear of patrol vehicle the suspect made statements that he wanted to take his life and he wished past attempts at suicide would have been successful.

The suspect was taken to Hospital and a Petition for Commitment and Evaluation was executed. Suspect was RPI'd on Trespassing charges.

**Special Attention: Death Investigation:
Press Release:**

On March 22, 2020 at approximately 9:45 p.m., the Southfield Police Department responded to the 26000 block of West Twelve Mile Road to investigate a report of gun shots heard. Upon arrival, officers located a female inside of an apartment that had been shot. The female was deceased at the scene.

Officers and Detectives investigating the homicide have developed reasonable suspicion that the female was killed by her boyfriend.

Officers conducted an area check for the suspect but he was not located. The investigation is ongoing.

The victim is a 29-year-old female that resides in Southfield.

Adrian Deshawn Hill, the 32-year-old boyfriend of the victim has been identified as a person of interest.

After the gunshots were heard, Hill was seen running from the apartment building. He then entered a maroon or white Dodge Ram 1500 pick-up truck and exited the parking lot of victims Apartment Complex. The pick-up truck bears a Michigan license plate of DWC-9109/MI.

Hill is a black male and is approximately 5'9" and 190lbs. He was last seen wearing a white jacket.

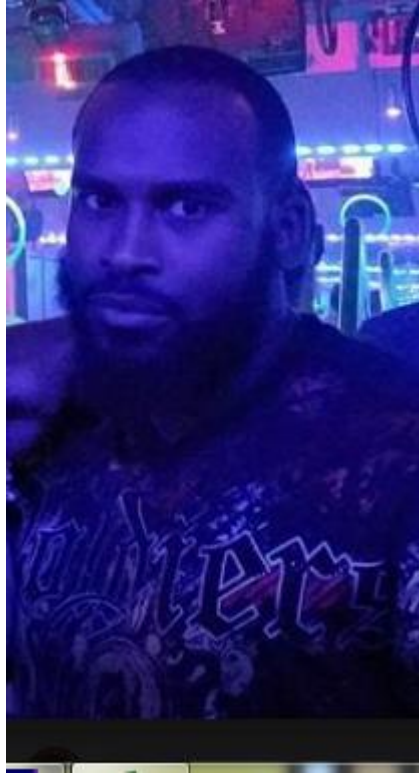

Officers responded to the 23000 Block of Grayson St. to investigate the possibility of a \$100.00 Counterfeit Bill being passed to the Pizza Delivery Person.

Victim stated he went up to the door of residence and was greeted by a tall B/M, with dreads. The B/M gave victim a \$100.00 bill to pay for his tab. Victim gave the suspect his change and because he didn't have the exact change to give suspect he was given a large tip.

When victim returned to his vehicle he realized the \$100.00 Bill wasn't real. He called the Police.

Officers arrived on scene and contacted the suspect at the residence in question. During questioning of the suspect, PC was established that the suspect knew he passed a counterfeit \$100.00 Bill. The suspect also had an outstanding warrant out of the 46th Dist. Ct. for Embezzlement. The suspect was taken into custody for Passing Counterfeit Currency & the Outstanding Warrant.
