All three vehicles were</p>
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			<p>associated with the suspects. The suspects can be seen forcing entry into victim's hotel room. Shortly after this you can see R/P and another female and male fleeing the room. R/P stated that her wallet was missing from her purse. Her ID and credit cards were in her wallet. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and collected evidence. One of R/P's credit cards was recovered. Investigation is on-going.</p>

Officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a White Chrysler 300 for a traffic offense on the Northwestern Service Dr. south of Evergreen Rd. A LEIN check on the plate showed that it was improper. The plate returned on a 2019 Lexus ES at residence on Greenwald Dr. in our city.

Officer caught up to the vehicle and it made several evasive maneuvers to avoid Officer.

On today's date, 04/01/2021, Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of Shiawassee Rd. for a report of a possible Domestic.

Dispatch advised a male and female subject were fighting in the parking lot. Dispatch later advised they had received several phone calls reporting shots were fired.

Officers arrived on scene and met with male victim. He advised his ex-girlfriend arrived in a White Chevrolet Impala with two unknown males around 6:00pm. R/P was arguing with his ex-girlfriend while she placed various items, such as clothing, on R/P's vehicle. R/P repeatedly told female to leave. His ex-girlfriend and the two unknown males got back in their car and drove over to an adjoining Apartment Complex where the yelling continued back in forth over the fence. R/P was still at his Apartments. Several shots were then fired from the suspect's vehicle. R/P was scared and ran inside his apartment building. R/P was not injured and he didn't know if the suspects shot at him or who did the shooting.

Officers recovered several spent shell casings in the parking lot where the shooting took place.

Information was developed that the suspects and suspect vehicle may reside at an Apartment Complex in the 25000 Block of Twelve Mile Rd. Officer was conducting stationary surveillance on the entrance to this Apartment Complex when he observed the suspect vehicle pull out of the complex and drive a short distance to a plaza on Twelve Mile Rd. Officer observed two males and female that matched the description of suspects exit the vehicle and go into the Store. When the subjects came back out to their vehicle Officers blocked the vehicle in. One of

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## **OWI/ DWLS/ R&O/ Assaulting P.O.- 1- Arrest**

Ranchwood Dr. & Alhambra St.

Officers were dispatched to 12 Mile Rd and Ranchwood Dr. for a reported property damage accident. Dispatch stated the male R/P said he was involved in an accident and believed his vehicle was no longer drivable. Dispatch stated the R/P sounded intoxicated.

Officers arrived on scene and observed the R/P's vehicle in the front yard next to a bush in the 28000 Block of Ranchwood.

Officers observed a telephone pole broken in half and uprooted from the ground in the front yard of residence. There were numerous low hanging electrical wires in residential yards and across the road, low hanging wires on top of houses and on top of R/P's vehicle. There was also a broken mailbox.

The R/P was sitting in the driver seat of his vehicle, and he was advised to stay in the vehicle due to the down wires on his vehicle.

The vehicle had accident damage all over the vehicle.

Officers observed the driver to have slurred speech, bloodshot eyes, and they could smell the odor of intoxicants coming off his breath.

When speaking with the driver he mumbled and was difficult to understand. Officers removed the driver from the passenger side of the vehicle. He was turned over to Southfield FD Life Support Unit and transported to Providence Hospital for treatment & a Blood Test.

At the Hospital, the suspect became combative. Additional Officers had to respond to the hospital along with Hospital Security. The suspect kicked, spit on and bit several Officers. Officers used the necessary force to secure the suspect and placed a spit mask over his face. He was eventually secured with handcuffs and hospital restraints.

OWI Investigation is on-going pending results of Blood Test.
