



Suspect#1 drove the female to her home (unknown location) and dropped her off. Suspect#1 then drove to an unknown location about 10 minutes away and parked the vehicle on the side of a main road. Suspect#1 made a phone call and his male friend (suspect#2) showed up on foot. The suspect jumped in the back seat of the vehicle. Victim described suspect#2 as a light skinned B/M with an afro about 170 lbs. When the suspect got in the vehicle, he said "what's up", and suspect#1 said "all is good". Officers went to Suspect#1 residence believe to
be in Southfield in the 24000 Block of Evergreen
Rd. (Apartments)
Officers located the suspect's vehicle, White
GMC Denali parked in the parking lot.
Officers observed two B/M subjects walking out
of the apartment building. One of the subjects
was identified as suspect#1.
Officers questioned suspect#1 and he gave
consent to search himself and his apartment.
During the search of apartment Officers located a
handgun and several prescription pills that were
concealed in the bottom of a cereal box under
the cereal.
Suspect#1 admitted that the pills were his and he
sells them on the street.
At this time suspect#1 was arrested for
Possession with Intent to Deliver Prescription
Narcotics. The Robbery is still under
