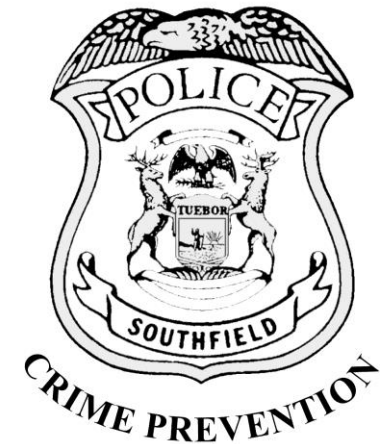

When he returned home he discovered someone had broken into his apartment. He found his apartment door open and the door frame damaged. The apartment had been ransacked. R/P went through the apartment and observed multiple items missing: Black Apple Mac Laptop, Black Laptop Bag, Michio Watch and a Gold Tennis Bracelet are missing. <b>Note:</b> A Neighbor states she had a similar incident to her apartment a few weeks prior. Another neighbor stated she heard loud noises coming from victim's apartment at approx. 10:00-1030am.

Unknown how entry was gained into apartment.</p>	<p>On 11/18/2021 at approx. 1:00pm R/P came into the front desk to file a report regarding her girlfriend, assaulting her and pointing a handgun at her. R/P stated she initially got into an argument with her girlfriend on 11/16/2021 because she had discovered she was talking to somebody else. There was some pushing and shoving and her girlfriend threw her cell phone in the toilet and flushed her sim card down the toilet. R/P left for the evening and returned the next day and discovered her TV had been broken as well as her window screen was damaged. She also noticed her purse had been rummaged through. On 11/18/2021 R/P's girlfriend arrived at her apartment door. The suspect began to beat and kick her door so victim let her in. The couple began to argue about the cellphone which escalated to her girlfriend assaulting her several times and allegedly pointed a gun at her and threatened her. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician took photos of victim's injuries. The suspect has been identified and investigation is on-going.</p>

**Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.**

**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Officers were dispatched to the 16000 Block of W. Nine Mile Rd. (Hospital) for a MDOP and an unwanted subject refusing to leave.

Officers arrived on scene and met with Hospital Security.

Security advised female came in for treatment but refused to complete necessary paperwork. She was advised she wouldn't be treated until they completed necessary paperwork. The female then started yelling and screaming, disturbing other patients and refused to leave when advised on Trespassing by Security.

The female then grabbed a table and threw it up against the wall braking it into pieces. She was handcuffed and secured by security until Police arrived.

Officers completed their investigation and placed suspect under arrest for MDOP. Officers searched suspects jacket and purse and located a fully functional stun gun. The stun gun was confiscated and the suspect was issued a citation. Further investigation by Officers resulted in the release of suspect and she was transported to another hospital due to her medical condition.



**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles**  
**How to prevent this from happening to you!**

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. -Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
