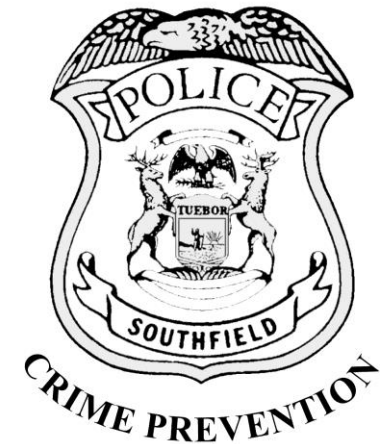
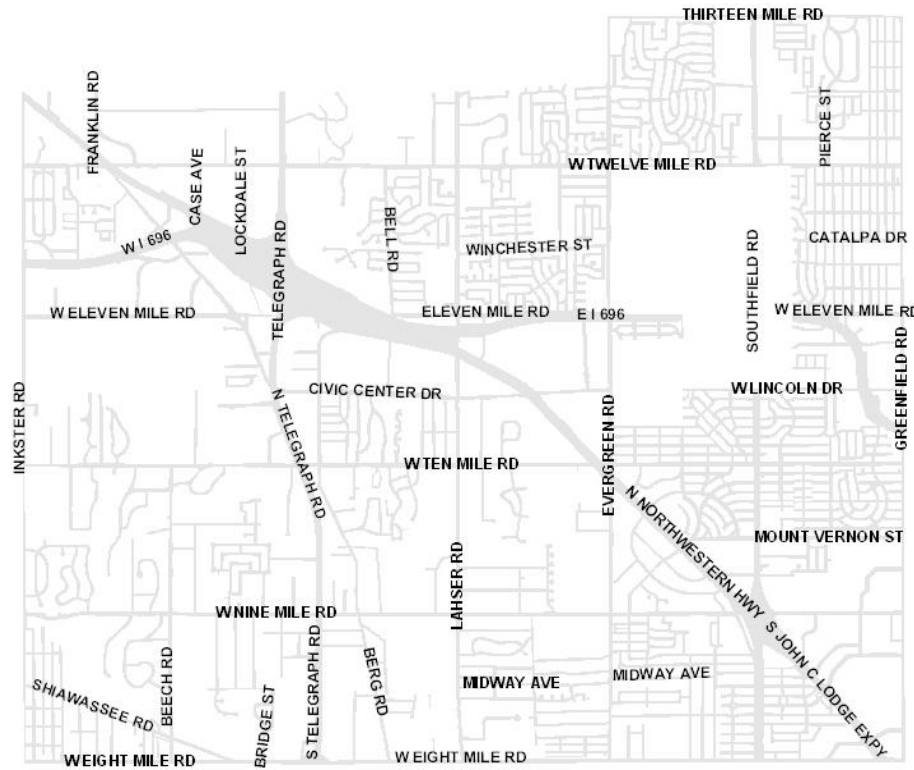

Dispatch stated it was a front and rear motion indicator.</p> <p>Officers were on scene at 4:04am.</p> <p>Officers discovered good B&E, the front door glass had been broken out. The shelving unit behind the front desk was completely rummaged through. There was loose change currency on the floor and a broken money tray. The medicine cabinets appeared rummaged through as well.</p> <p>Surveillance video from the business shows at 3:54am a Small Silver SUV/Crossover Vehicle is seen in the parking lot. Two male suspects walk up to the front door and look inside. Both suspects were wearing hoodies, face masks, gloves, and dark pants. The two suspects return to the suspect vehicle and it briefly pulls away out of camera view. Vehicle returns with only headlights showing on camera.</p> <p>Four suspects walk up to the front glass door. All the suspects were wearing masks, hoodies, gloves, dark pants and tennis shoes.</p> <p>One suspect is holding a crow bar and used it to break the lower part of the glass door.</p> <p>Suspects crawl through the shattered door and immediately walk to the back of the pharmacy.</p> <p>At 3:47am the suspects run out of the pharmacy.</p> <p>One suspect, wearing a mask, hoodie, gloves, dark pants, tennis shoes, can be seen carrying the cash</p>

			<p>register. One suspect leaves with the crow bar. The owner was on-scene and stated there was an undisclosed amount of cash in the cash register. Unknown what medications were taken but it doesn't appear that any high- end medications were taken. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was on location to process the scene.</p>

Officers arrived on scene and contacted the two victims and a witness. One of the victims stated they met up with a person only known by his first name that he has smoked weed with in the past. He had some fliers for his business that he wanted to give him so they decided to meet up and smoke some weed. The two victims arrived in the parking lot at approx. 4:00pm. The suspect walked out of the apartment complex and got into the back seat of victim's vehicle. They smoked for approx. ten minutes before the suspect asked them if they wanted to go upstairs to his apartment. Victims went into the apartment building and entered an unknown apartment. When they entered, there were two unknown subjects that were each armed with handguns. The unknown suspects had their guns pointed at victims. The unknown suspects escorted victims into a bedroom where they were robbed of their cell phones and cash. During the Robbery one of the victims slipped out of the zip ties and confronted one of the gunmen. There was a struggle and 3-4 shots went off into the floor. The suspects then fled the apartment. The victims went back out into the</p>

			<p>parking lot and flagged down a citizen and borrowed his phone to call the police. Both victim's cell phones were later recovered in the apartment where the Robbery occurred. The cash that was taken was not recovered. The apartment was located and found to be a vacant apartment.</p> <p>A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and recovered spent bullet fragments and spent shell casings.</p> <p>Suspects:</p> <p>S1: B/M, 20-30 y.o.a. approximately 5'8", medium build, LSW a black ski mask, and a black and camo jacket. He parked next to the air filler. He noticed a Silver Chrysler 200 pull up nearby and a young black male wearing a ski mask and possibly a gray and red hoodie approached him. The subject wanted his car. Victim was not sure exactly what the suspect said but he knew he was getting robbed. Victim started to run away when he was shot. He</p>

			<p>fell onto the ground. The suspect went up to him, reached into his pocket and removed the car keys. The second suspect exited the Chrysler 200 and approached him. One of the suspects drove off in the Jeep and the other left in the Chrysler. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the scene for processing. Information was later gathered that the same type of incidents involving same suspects have occurred in Dearborn and Detroit. Southfield Officers worked in conjunction with Dearborn PD and DPD and together all three-agencies made several arrests and believed the suspects arrested were involved in the Southfield incident. One of the subjects had the key fob in his pocket for the Black Jeep Cherokee that was taken in our incident.</p> <p>On 11/12/2021 at 3:50am, Officer was dispatched to a location in Detroit and recovered the Black Jeep Cherokee that was taken in our Car Jacking. The vehicle was in an empty lot and the plate on the vehicle was missing. The keys were missing from the vehicle and the vehicle was not running. The vehicle was unoccupied and no arrests were made.</p> <p>Investigation is on-going.</p>

On 11/09/2021 Officer received a call from a concerned person stating that no one was currently living at residence in the 21000 Block of Westover but there were two dogs living in unsanitary conditions on the back porch. The caller stated they hadn't seen anyone coming to take care of the dogs. Officer receiving this information was familiar with the address as we have had several animal complaints there in the past. The most recent one being Animal Neglect on 07/19/2021. Officer arrived on scene and met with the homeowner. He stated his daughter was staying at the house and was the owner of the dogs. The owner doesn't live there, he was there to do some work on the house. Officer found two dogs in the enclosed back porch that were soiled in feces and urine. One of the dogs was locked in a crate. There was no water or food present for the dogs and they both appeared to be in distress. The dogs were impounded for their health and safety. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded and took photos of the dogs and the

11/13/2021 1:19am

29000 Block of Northwestern Hwy.

On 11/13/2021, Southfield Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Northwestern Hwy (Bar & Grill) on a report of a stabbing. Dispatch advised the incident occurred in the parking lot. Possible suspect vehicle was a Black Jeep. Officer located the vehicle s/b on Northwestern and Twelve Mile Rd. Officer advised the vehicle was not stopping. Additional Officers made the area and assisted.

The vehicle came to a stop on s/b M-10 n/o Telegraph Rd. A b/m who was later identified exited the vehicle. The subject would not comply with officer's commands and re-entered the vehicle. He began to drive off until another patrol car blocked him in. The subject again exited the vehicle and officers observed subject to have an injury (Stab Wound) to his left abdomen. (TOTB Victim in Assault) Officers observed a second male in the rear seat, who was later identified and interviewed. Other Officers located and interviewed the other subject involved in this incident. He was at Providence Hospital. He had several injuries including stab wounds as well.

Further investigation revealed that the incident took place in the parking lot outside a Bar & Grill in the 29000 Block of Northwestern Hwy. Suspect had placed his food on victim's vehicle and was eating it while victim and a friend were sitting in his vehicle. Victim exited his vehicle and told suspect to get off his car. The two exchanged words until it was alleged that suspect pulled a knife with an orange handle out of his pocket and jabbed victim in the abdomen with the knife. The passenger in the vehicle then exited the vehicle and started fighting with suspect. Everyone then left after the incident. The suspect stated he was attacked by three persons that robbed him of his chain and pendant. Thinks it was a set up. One of the suspects had a knife that he took from this person and jabbed him with the knife. The suspect

never gave Officers any information of how he was stabbed or who stabbed him. The suspect was eventually taken into custody. His vehicle was impounded. During the vehicle inventory, Officers located a handgun, a folding knife and a duffle bag with a large amount suspected Marijuana, scale and packaging material inside. Southfield Dispatch confirmed that suspect did not have a concealed weapons permit. Dispatch also confirmed that suspect had several previous felony convictions. The suspect was taken into custody for Assault GBH, CCW, Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
