28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy.

(Commercial- Bar/ Lounge)

Several Officers were dispatched to the 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy (Bar/ Lounge) for a report of a fight.

Dispatch stated there were a large amount of people fighting in the parking lot. Dispatch updated and said several shots were heard in the parking lot and a subject was armed possibly with an assault rifle.

As Officers arrived on scene there were several vehicles leaving the parking lot. Officers did an area check in the lot for any suspects/witnesses to no avail. Officers observed broken glass with suspected bullet holes in the front window of an adjacent business. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was dispatched to the scene for processing. Officers observed spent shell casings in the parking lot and near the front door of business.

No victims of a shooting were located. Dispatch contacted local hospitals for any victims with negative results.

It appears unknown suspects fired shots from a vehicle as they were leaving the bar.

Officers found a victim of a physical assault inside the establishment. He stated he was physically attacked inside the bar and then refused to give any further information.

Security confirmed that victim was attacked inside the bar.

The victim was attacked by 6-7 persons. Security broke the fight up and everyone left the bar. Shortly after leaving the bar Security Person heard gunshots but didn't see who was

Officers were on routine patrol N/B Telegraph Rd. near Ten Mile Rd. when they observed a Red Chevrolet Tahoe driving N/B Telegraph Rd. in the far-left lane to the rear of their patrol car. Officers observed the Tahoe commit a traffic violation. They attempted to slow down to get behind the Tahoe and the vehicle slowed down to approximately 30MPH, refusing to pass Officers patrol vehicle.
