From: 10/15/2019 4:30pm To: 10/16/2019 9:00am	27000 Franklin Rd. (Apartment- Maintenance Shop)	Door was kicked in.	Security Officer from Apartment Complex in the 27000 Block of Franklin Rd. reported that unknown suspects kicked in the door to the maintenance garage between 10/15/2019 at 4:30pm and 10/16/2019 at 9:00am. Once inside the garage the suspects started and removed a 2017 Bobcat Tractor. Southfield Detectives located and recovered the tractor at a pawn shop in Detroit. Surveillance Video from Apartment Complex and the Pawn Shop showed the same suspect, vehicle & trailer that took the tractor was the same suspect that pawned the tractor. The suspects name and fingerprint were obtained from the Pawn Shop. The suspect has been identified and incident is under further investigation.

Victim states he was gone from his apartment between 6:30am- 3:30pm. When he returned he discovered his apartment door unlocked and several items were missing. Victim has two roommates and some of their belongings were missing as well. It doesn't appear there was any forced entry into the apartment. Possibly the door was left unsecured.</p> <p>Officers spoke to a maintenance worker that stated between 11:00am-12:00pm he was on the 4th floor of apartment with a pest control contractor when he observed two B/M's in the hallway near victim's apartment. The B/M's were both in the mid 40's, short, 5'7" to 5'9". Maintenance worker stated he observed the B/M's leave, pulling a suitcase. They walked into the courtyard to the parking lot to a small U-Haul box truck. It's likely that the two men were caught on surveillance video from the complex. Victim has seen this person before but does not know his real name, only his nick name "Moe." Victim got into the front passenger seat of a White Chevrolet Impala with an out of state plate, possibly Kentucky at Meyers and Santa Clara Street in Detroit. Suspect drove victim to her pharmacy in Detroit where she picked up her prescriptions. Suspect then drove to an Apartment Complex in Southfield (Shiawassee & 8 Mile Rd) where he produced a handgun and robbed victim of all her prescriptions and an undisclosed amount of cash. Victim described suspect as a B/M, approx. 30-40 years of age, short, stocky build and has a salt and pepper colored beard. Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Lahser Rd. on a report of a stabbing.

Officers arrived on scene and located male that had sustained several stab wounds.

Investigation revealed that the male had first attacked his girlfriend and assaulted her several times and attempted to choke her out. The female ran to the kitchen, grabbed a knife to protect herself and as the assault continued she stabbed the male.

The incident was confirmed by a witness.

The male was taken to the hospital for treatment and was RPI'd due to him being admitted into the hospital. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the hospital and took photos of suspects injuries.

This incident will be submitted to the OCPO for complaint & Warrant.

(Apartments)

R/P from Guard Shack at Apartment Complex states he was working and observed the following:

At approx. 1:15am a Grey 4 door Sedan left the apartment complex and turned north on Berg Rd. The vehicle was occupied by two unknown black males. Upon exiting, the vehicle slowed down and the front passenger fired several shots out the passenger side window. R/P believes the suspect was shooting at a group of deer near the 26000 Block of Berg Rd.

Shortly after the shooting a call came in from a citizen stating he was asleep in bed and was startled by the sound of breaking glass. Upon turning on the bedroom lights he noticed the window was broken out and his blinds were damaged. It was later determined that the damage was caused by a bullet. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was called to the scene for processing. Nobody was injured in this incident.

On 10/21/2019 a second resident from apartment complex found what looked like a bullet hole in his apartment. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was called to this scene as well and a spent bullet was recovered from the apartment. No injuries to report. This incident is under investigation.

Officers were dispatched to the 20000 Block of Southfield Rd. (Gas Station) for a civil matter.

Officers arrived on scene and located a female that was inside the gas station waiting for Officers. As soon as Officers entered the gas station they could smell the odor of intoxicants coming from the female. Officers spoke with the clerk who said female pulled to the front of the building came inside and said she wanted to pump gas, money was never exchanged at this point. The female left and then reentered the station and started asking for her money back. She was told she never gave him any money.

Officers then spoke to the female and it was difficult to illicit what she was saying because she was intoxicated. She did tell Officers that she had a couple glasses of wine and was at a family party. She stopped in the gas station to get some gas.

Officers ran the female and discovered she had a valid CPL. The female told Officers she was carrying and her handgun was on her hip. The handgun was confiscated and the female was asked to take a PBT. The female submitted to a PBT and the result was extremely over the limit. The female was also asked to perform several sobriety tests. After the PBT and Sobriety Tests were completed, the female was taken into custody for OWI & Possession of a Firearm While Intoxicated.
