

Officers arrived at location and spoke with on duty Security Officer. Security Officer stated that while doing routine pat downs at the Lounge's front door he encountered suspect. Suspect attempted to enter the lounge but was denied access after he was found with a pocket knife on his person. Suspect left the bar but returned shortly thereafter attempting to regain entry.

Security performed another pat down of suspect, this time Security located a handgun on suspects person.

The suspect was told again he couldn't come into the business and this time he was advised he was banned from the business. The Security Officer was then overridden by the Lounge's Management and was told to let suspect into the lounge??? Shortly after suspect was allowed entry into the lounge Security Officer heard 2 gunshots. Security Officer looked in the direction of the gunshots and observed same suspect that was armed and allowed entry concealing a handgun into his waist band and fleeing the lounge limping as if he had shot himself.

The suspect was later located at Hospital with what appeared to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound. The suspect denied having been shot or shooting
