

The homeowner immediately got into her vehicle with her children and left the area to wait for Officers. Officers arrived on scene and discovered that it was a good Home Invasion. There were no suspects located. It appeared that the suspect(s) focused on the master bedroom. Several dresser drawers were open and clothing was thrown throughout the room. Several items were taken. Victims Surveillance camera's inside the residence shows a male subject entering the house through the garage door at 8:35pm. The male is observed walking though out the home and into the master bedroom. The male is seen leaving with a small Black Box that R/P states was her safe deposit box. The male is in the house for approx. 5 minutes before leaving through

			the garage door at approx. 8:40pm. The male suspect is a B/M, tall and thin, wearing a Black Nike Hoodie with the hood up and a White Nike Insignia on the left breast of the hoodie, unknown color full length pants, a white surgical mask, and light blue latex gloves.

Victim showed Officers several text messages from his ex-girlfriend that would indicate that she was responsible for the Attempt Home Invasion and she threatened bodily harm to R/P. Suspect has been identified and investigation is on-going. Victim was advised to get PPO.

Details
R/P states herself and her male friend were inside their vehicle that was parked adjacent to condo complex in the 16000 Block of Eleven Mile Rd. R/P was in the driver's seat and her male friend was in the passenger seat. Two B/M's approached the vehicle on either side. Suspect# 1 who approached the drivers side told her to open the door and to get out of the vehicle while pointing a handgun at her. R/P complied with the suspects demands. Suspect#2 was on the passenger side of the vehicle. R/P's male friend was also removed from the vehicle at gun point and eventually ran in an unknown direction. Both suspects then got in victims 2020 Silver Ford Fusion and drove off last seen going E/B on 11 Mile towards Greenfield Rd. R/P stated there was a Black Pick Up Truck following close behind victim's vehicle. 2- B/M suspects, 5-9, thin build, both wearing masks & both had handguns. Nothing further. R/P advised Officers that her phone was in the car when it was taken. R/P had an app. on her phone so she could track her phone. Officers tracked the phone to a location in Detroit where victim's vehicle was located and recovered.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- -If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

Fleeing & Eluding/ R&C Motor Vehicle/ CCW/ R&O- 1- Arrest 10/07/2021 2:41pm

W Eight Mile Rd. & Stahelin Rd.

On 10/07/21 at approx. 2:40pm, Officer overheard radio traffic from Detroit Police Department that they were pursuing a Grey Dodge Charger E/B on I-96 at Evergreen. The Charger was wanted for an Armed Robbery and Felonious Assault on a Police Officer. The Charger was possibly wanted in conjunction with an officer involved shooting. The wanted Charger had an improper plate on it. DPD officers lost sight of the Charger near I-96 and Southfield Rd.

Officers observed the Grey Charger Exit N/B Southfield Freeway at 8 Mile. The Charger had the improper plate on it. Officers observed the Charger driving in a reckless manner and it proceeded to travel W/B on 8 Mile from Southfield. Officer activated his lights and siren and attempted to stop the vehicle. The driver ignored his lights & siren and the vehicle did not stop and continued to flee w/b on 8 Mile Rd. As the Charger approached Berg Rd, the driver attempted to enter the median on 8 Mile to go back E/B. As the Charger slowed up to enter the median, Officer made intentional contact with the Charger to prevent any further pursuit. The impact from the intentional contact disabled the suspect's vehicle. The driver (lone occupant) exited the driver seat and fled on foot s/b across 8 Mile Rd.

Officers pursued the suspect on foot into a parking lot and to the rear of a building then back N/B on the other side of the building. While pursuing the suspect on foot, Officers gave multiple verbal commands for the suspect to stop. He continued to flee on foot S/B on Redfern St. Officers caught up to the suspect on Redfern St. just south of 8 Mile Rd. where he was taken into custody without further incident. He was searched and placed into scout car. As the suspect was being placed in the scout car, a black ski mask fell out from under his clothing. The ski mask was seized as evidence and TOT to Southfield Police Evidence

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.

Technician. A handgun with an extended magazine was also recovered from the Charger. The Charger was found to be stolen out of Warren on 9/15/2021. Multiple Southfield and Detroit PD scout cars arrived on scene to assist. The suspect was taken into custody for R&C Motor Vehicle/Flee & Elude/CCW and R&O. DPD is investigating possible further charges.

Special Attention: Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier. How to prevent this from happening to you! Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.
