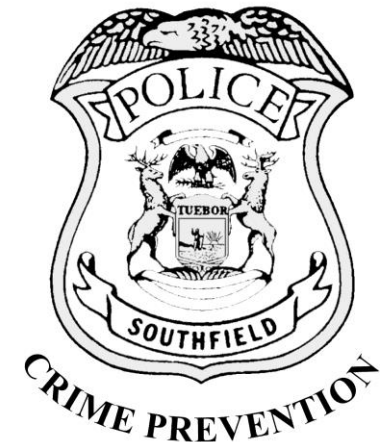
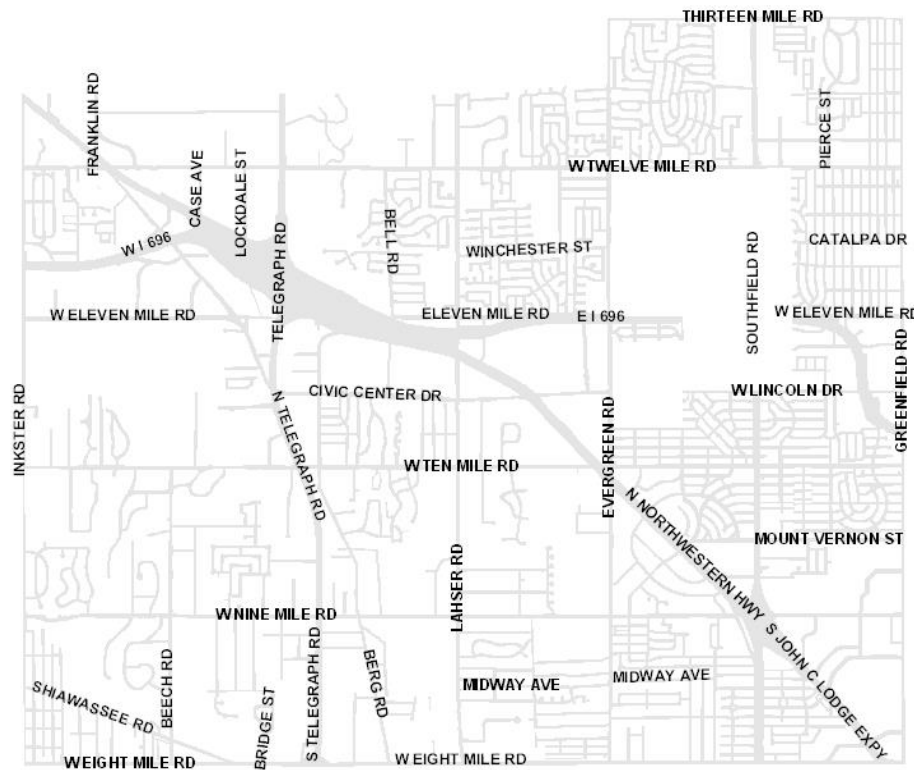

Victim states suspect showed up to her suite unexpectedly around 3:00pm. Officers responded at the time but the male suspect had already left the scene. The suspect returned to the suite around 5:00pm. R/P was working on a customer's hair. The suspect knocked on the door a few times but R/P did not open the door, it was locked. The suspect kicked the door open and entered the suite. The suspect began damaging everything in suite. He punched the mounted TV, flipped the sofa in the suite and damaged numerous other items in the suite. The suspect then went outside, jumped on R/P's car and broke out the front and rear windows. R/P had just had the same windows fixed. Suspect broke out the windows on another earlier date. Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

The pursuit was terminated at Northwestern & 13 Mile Rd. Officers returned to the city. A short time later Southfield Dispatch advised that the suspect vehicle was S/B on Inkster from Maple and it had struck several vehicles.</p> <p>A short time later, Officers observed the suspect vehicle back in Southfield S/B on Inkster at Northwestern. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle but it fled from Officers again. The pursuit was terminated again.</p> <p>The vehicle was last seen W/B on 12 Mile Rd. from Inkster Rd. driving on a flat tire.</p> <p>Officers located the vehicle unoccupied in Farmington Hills on a side street just South of 12 Mile Rd. The caller stated her friend had been shot by an unknown male. R/P also stated money had been taken from them by the suspects.</p> <p>Upon arrival Officers located the victim in the hotel room sitting on the floor in front of the bed. Officers immediately began assessing victim's injuries. She was later transported to the hospital for treatment.</p> <p>The R/P had a large contusion with abrasions on the right side of her forehead.</p> <p>R/P stated an Arabic male was in the room with her female friend (Prostitute) and her. The Arabic male and her friend had sex together in the hotel room. As the Arabic male was leaving, an unknown B/M forced his way into the room wielding a pistol. He used the bottom of the handle of the pistol to strike her on the forehead at least three times. The unknown B/M demanded money from the females. He then struck R/P's female friend with the pistol. The unknown B/M then shot her female friend with the pistol as they were struggling.</p> <p>The Arabic male was wearing a white t-shirt, a black jacket, jeans, and colorful shoes. The black male was described as wearing all black. The</p>

			<p>suspects took victims money before fleeing the room. Based on the description of the suspects and the circumstances, this is believed to be the same suspects who had committed similar Robbery's at other hotels in the city. Through investigation of the other incidents, the suspects were identified.</p> <p>On 09/16/2021 TCSU Officers were conducting surveillance at one of the suspects residence. He was observed entering his vehicle and was followed to a business in Detroit where he was taken into custody.</p> <p>The suspect had a handgun in his possession that was recovered. It was later discovered that the handgun was reported stolen out of Detroit. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician made the scene for photographs, he collected the suspects handgun, cellphone and clothing.</p> <p>The suspect's vehicle was also impounded.</p> <p>Note: The second suspect hasn't been located as of this date.</p>

Be on the Look Out Highlights:**Leaving the Scene of Serious Injury Traffic****Crash: Suspects Wanted!**

09/19/2021 9:00pm

Northwestern Hwy. & J L Hudson Dr.

Officers responded to the area of Northwestern Service Dr. and JL Hudson Dr. on a report of an injury accident between a motorcycle and a vehicle.

Witnesses observed the two occupants of the car flee the scene on foot after the crash. Officers found the motorcyclist to have significant injuries.

Traffic Safety Officer responded to the scene and completed scans of the scene using the FARO.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician was also on-scene processing and taking photos.

An Oak Park K-9 Unit responded to the scene and conducted a track. The track was suspended in the north parking lot of the 16000 Block of North Park Dr. Further investigation, Officers developed two suspects. Both suspects have addresses in Southfield. Both residences were checked and the suspects were not located.

Officers investigation eventually led then to the male suspects mothers house which is approximately a 1/4 mile from the crash scene. This residence is also very close to where the K-9 track was terminated.

Contact was made with family members at this residence. Information was gathered that the two suspects had been at the residence prior to Officers arrival.

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

(Commercial- Home Goods)

Officer was dispatched to the 30000 Block of Southfield Rd. for a Retail Fraud. Dispatch advised 2 B/M's took several cases of Red Bull from the store without paying. They left N/B on Southfield Rd. in a Black Dodge Charger. The suspects were not located.

A short time later Dispatch advised the 2 B/M suspects were back in the store and switching price tags on items. The suspects were loading a cart up with Red Bull and were at the front of the store. Officers arrived on scene and identified the suspects as the same 2 suspects from earlier incident. Both suspects were taken into custody for Retail Fraud.

The suspects had been under surveillance by Loss Prevention. On the second incident, the suspects were observed loading several cases of Red Bull into a shopping cart. They were then observed putting \$2.00 Barcodes on the cases. The suspects were at the self-checkout when Officers arrived on scene. Their vehicle was impounded.

One set of Brass Knuckles was recovered from the suspects' vehicle.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles

How to prevent this from happening to you!

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers

as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
