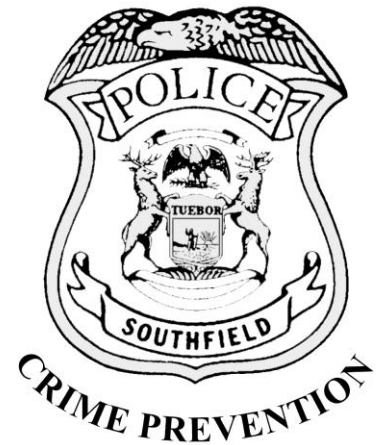
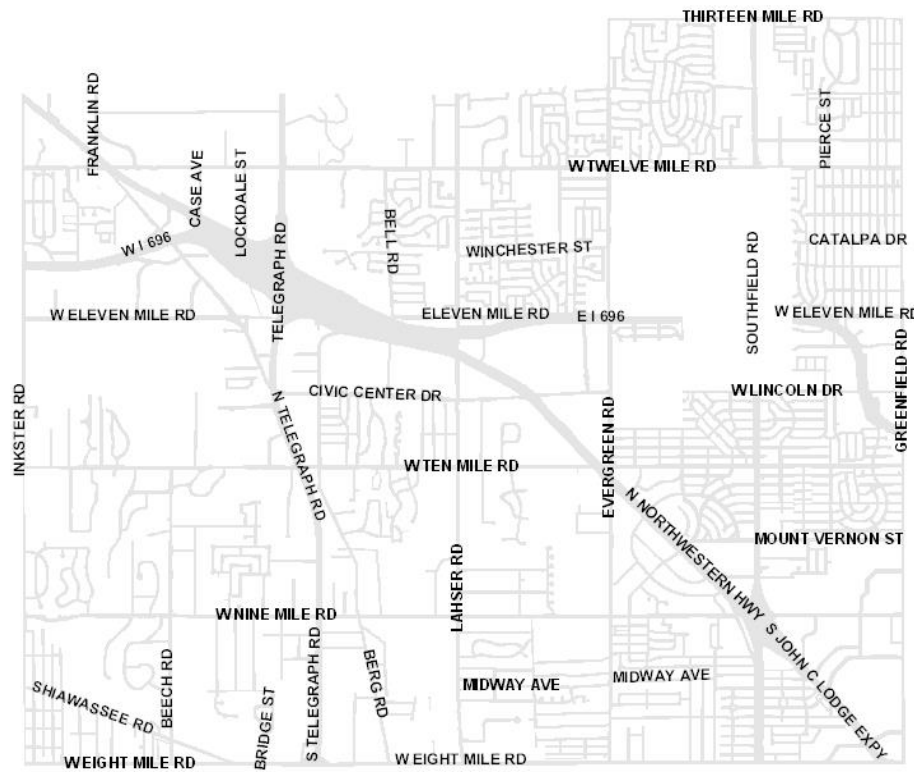

Officers responded on a report of a shooting. Preliminary Information is that two males ran out of gas and were at the Valero Gas Station. At that time, they were approached by three males in a Grey Charger. An altercation ensued and one of the males that fled into the gas station was shot. The second subject was found walking a short distance away and was non-compliant with police officers. It was unknown what his role in the incident was and he was taken into custody. It was later discovered that he was high on cocaine and had been drinking. It was also discovered that he was absconder from the WCSO tether program. He was taken into custody for R&O.

Southfield Police Detectives and Evidence Technician responded to the scene. The subject that was shot is being treated for GSW's to the arm.

Investigation is on-going.

W Eight Mile Rd. & Evergreen Rd.

On 09/28/2021 at 6:04pm, Officer was on routine patrol at W/B Eight Mile near Southfield when he located a Gray Dodge Challenger Scat Pack travelling W/B Eight Mile. Officer ran the Plate on the vehicle, and it returned as a stolen vehicle out of Oak Park entered on 09/23/2021. Officer continued to follow the vehicle awaiting back up.

After the vehicle pulled into the business on 8 Mile Rd. just west of Lahser, additional Officers assisted in boxing in the vehicle. All three occupants were removed from the vehicle and detained while Officers conducted their investigation.

After completing their investigation all three occupants were taken into custody for R&C Motor vehicle.

Officers recovered a key fob from one of the suspects that was for a Jeep Trail Hawk. The stolen vehicle responded to this key fob but was not the correct key fob for the vehicle. (Fob was re-programmed) The sunroof was also broken out on the stolen vehicle. The driver of the vehicle had a suspended license and two of the occupants were in possession of Prescription Drugs w/o a prescription.

Follow Up and Arrests:

Possible Suspects from Shooting:

While on patrol, Officer located a stolen vehicle out of Oak Park.

INFORMATION:

Officers had the vehicle stopped at business on E/B 8 Mile at Lahser on the Detroit side. All occupants were detained and secured. While on scene, Officers recognized the vehicle to be a possible match to the suspect vehicle involved in the shooting. Occupants in the vehicle also matched the descriptions of the three suspects. All three occupants of the vehicle were arrested for R&C Motor Vehicle.

Investigation regarding shooting is on-going.

Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier.

How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

On 09/29/2021, Officers were dispatched to Eight Mile and Telegraph for a Felonious Assault. Dispatch advised a subject driving a white tow truck pointed a pistol at the reporting party.

R/P stated a W/M driving a Tow Truck was tailgating him. He tapped his brakes which upset the Tow truck driver. He then pulled up next to R/P and pointed a handgun at him.

Officer located and stopped the suspect and tow truck.

During the stop a handgun was recovered from the tow truck.

The driver did not have a CPL and was taken into custody for CCW.

It was determined that the F/A with the handgun occurred in Detroit.

Telegraph Rd south of 8 Mile Rd. DPD showed up and they will investigate the F/A that occurred in their city.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles
How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers

Several Southfield Officers were dispatched to the 26000 Block of American Dr. (Hotel) for a report of a stabbing.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke with parties involved in the incident. Officers investigation revealed that female suspect, ex-girlfriend to victim showed up at hotel where her ex-boyfriend and his new girlfriend were celebrating him getting a new job.

At some point during the celebration the female suspect and male victim got into a verbal argument that escalated to female suspect stabbing male victim in the arm. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician processed the scene and recovered a knife.

The injuries were serious and the male victim was transported to the hospital for treatment. The female suspect was taken into custody for Domestic F/A.

as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

-Citizens should always be mindful not to leave anything of value in their vehicles. Especially wallets, purses, cash, handguns, cell phones, laptops, jewelry, or anything else of value. If you must leave your handgun in your vehicle it should be kept in a gun lock box that is bolted down in the trunk of the vehicle. At the very least you should try to hide the handgun somewhere that it would be difficult to find. The first place that criminals will look is under the front seat, in the center console or in the glove box.
