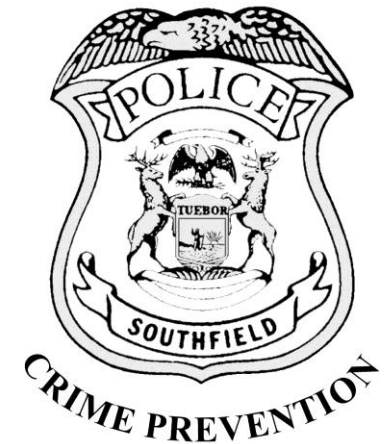
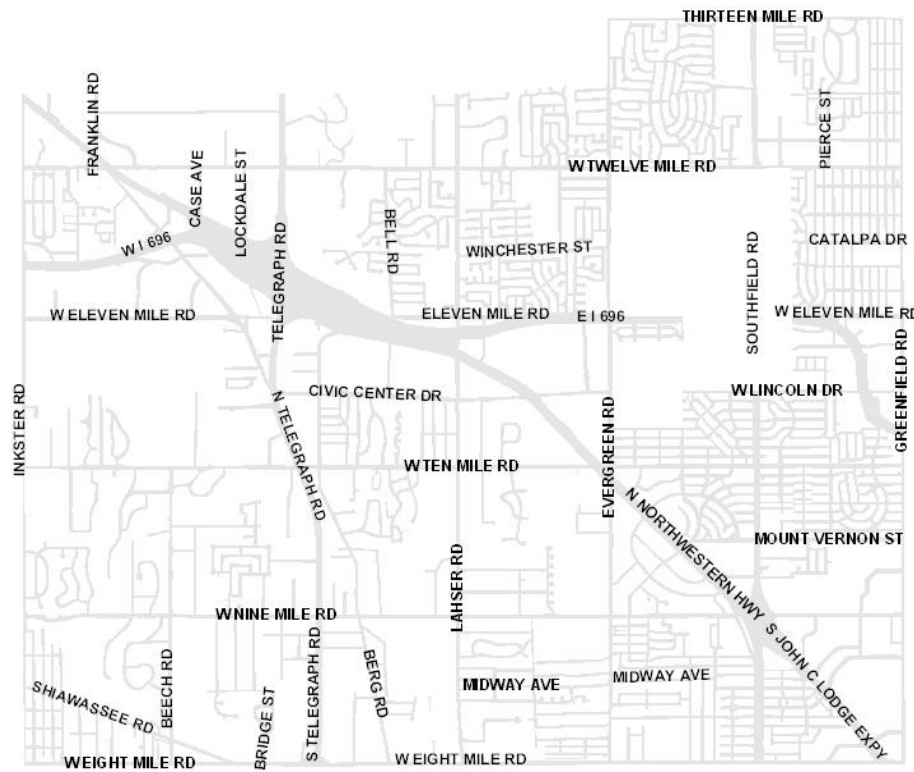

The door to the left had the bolt cut from around the lock. Rear Doors: The first door above the knob and the door was bent inward by the locking mechanism. The door adjacent to the loading garage had the dead bolt locking mechanism ripped off leaving parts on the ground and entry to that gained.</p>	<p>On 09/12/2020, Officers were dispatched to the 21000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd. (Market) on a report of an alarm. Officers determined that it was a good B&E (Inc.# 20 30634). The actual Market wasn't entered but a storage facility associated with the market was entered by force. While looking at doors adjacent to this business Officers observed the door handle broken off on a second business. Entry wasn't gained into this business. There was also graffiti written on the door to this business that was photographed & documented. K-9 tracked to a parking lot across the street from businesses that were attacked and stalled out. It's believed that the suspect(s) parked their vehicle at this location.</p>

R/P advised that the male suspect got into a vehicle, possibly a Chrysler 200 and went s/b on Berg Rd. Victim states her son (suspect) arrived at her home in a vehicle driven by another male. (Dark Colored Chrysler) Her son immediately forced his way into the residence while R/P was trying to close the door. The suspect demanded money and food from R/P. He started knocking things over in the house until R/P told him she would give him some money. R/P asked him to go outside and she would bring him the money. He complied. R/P gave suspect some money and they both started arguing verbally out on the front lawn. R/P's son eventually left in a Dark Colored Chrysler 200. The suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

It was reported by a witness that the suspects used three different guns, one that looked like a machine gun. The suspects stated after firing their guns they took them to a room at a nearby Hotel. There was a female friend that was staying at the hotel. Officers were unable to locate the female or the guns. It was later, reported that the female had taken the guns to her residence in another jurisdiction.

The suspects were identified and released pending further investigation.

Police Warrant Scam

Who Is It Targeting: Local residents

What Is It: A scam to extort money using fear referencing a Warrant for your arrest

What is the Caller Saying During The Phone Call: Once the victim answers the phone the caller states, The Southfield Police Department has issued a warrant for your arrest due to; unpaid tickets, failure to comply with a Subpoena, etc. etc. The number appearing on the caller ID actually lists the phone number and the name of the Southfield Police Department, this is known as "spoofing". **The victim is instructed to purchase gift card(s), and/or Greendot card(s), loading money onto the card(s) while the caller is still on the line.** Once the card(s) are purchased the caller advises the victim to give the numbers located on the back of the gift
