



Police Warrant Scam

Who Is It Targeting: Local residents

What Is It: A scam to extort money using fear referencing a Warrant for your arrest

What is the Caller Saying During The Phone Call: Once the victim answers the phone the caller states, The Southfield Police Department has issued a warrant for your arrest due to; unpaid tickets, failure to comply with a Subpoena, etc. etc. The number appearing on the caller ID actually lists the phone number and the name of the Southfield Police Department, this is known as **"spoofing". The victim is instructed to purchase gift card(s), and/or** Greendot card(s), loading money onto the card(s) while the caller is still on the line. Once the card(s) are purchased the caller advises the victim to give the numbers located on the back of the gift

Note: When Southfield Detectives contacted victim, she told them that she didn't wish to continue her complaint.

Citizens that meet strangers on Tinder or any other dating site should never meet anyone in a secluded area or an area that isn't safe. A good meeting place would be where there are lots of people like a café or restaurant. The first time you meet someone you may want to bring a friend and you should always let someone know that your meeting someone and where your meeting them. In this incident, the suspect refused to give R/P his address and insisted on meeting her in the parking lot. This is a big flag that this person had bad intentions!! card(s), at which time they then download the funds.

How Can You Avoid It:

- You will never receive a phone call from the Southfield Police Department requesting money for a warrant. Matters involving financial payments concerning warrants are handled through the 46th District Court or the 6th Circuit Court at which time a receipt is given.
- Never, ever agree to meet someone at a strange address to pay demands on cash payment.
- Never send money though the US Postal Service, FedEx, UPS or any other mailing entity.
- Never purchase gift cards and/or Greendot cards as the form of payment for a warrant.
- Never give your bank account information over the phone, nor your personal identifying information such as your Social Security Number or Driver's License information
