






Southfield undergoes profound change following WWII ~ Reflects shifts in American life

This house on Lone Elm in the Cranbrook Subdivision was given away at the 1957 Metropolitan Detroit Builders Home Show.






Southfield was the fastest growing city in Michigan in the 1960s




Copied around the world, the modern shopping mall was born in Southfield.

- Package pickup



Northland Mall New concept in shopping ~ Open spaces, gardens, art and outdoor seating







Northland surpassed all expectations in retail sales. The intersection of Northwestern & Eight Mile became the most traveled in Michigan. The mall spawned 29 office buildings, restaurants, three hotels, a movie theater, other retail, a hospital and numerous apartment buildings in Southfield. Many other developments followed in Oak Park & Detroit.














Residential Structure Example

- Façade consists of gold aluminum frames and tinted glass windows.
- · Decorative metal frames shade the large windows from the sun.
- · Main entrance includes large, mirrored windows.
- The second story is constructed larger than the first story; creating a cantilevered overhang with tributary area at the ground level.
