APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

PERMIT TO OCCUPY CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

The applicant for a Permit to Occupy right-of-way hereby agrees:

- 1. To furnish to the Southfield Engineering Department for review, three (3) sets of plans for the proposed public utility or improvement. (Additional copies will be needed upon the notification by the Engineering Department.)
- 2. To submit a detailed engineer's cost estimate for all site improvements.
- 3. To pay to the City a non-refundable fee in the amount of 2.0% of the estimated cost provided above.
- 4. To advise the contractor that approval of the plans accompanying this application does not constitute a construction permit. A Permit to Construct within City right-of-way must be applied for. Applications are available from the Engineering Department and on City web site.

The City further requires that the applicant provide the City with easements for all proposed public utilities or improvements that are not already located within City right-of-way. These easements shall be for the purpose of maintaining and operating these utilities or improvements by the City. Easements shall be submitted on forms provided by the City and are available from the Engineering Department and on City web site.
