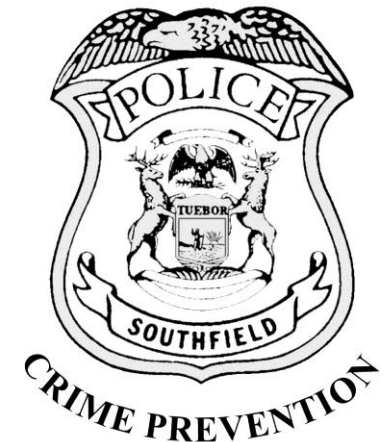

(2:00am)</p> <p>Officers arrived and observed two subjects with tire irons running through the lot. Several vehicles had their lug nuts removed. The suspects fled over the fence into the wooded ravine. A K-9 Unit conducted track for suspects. K-9 Unit searched the ravine and into a swamp area with approximately two feet of standing water. K-9 Unit located suspect boots which appeared to have come off in the mud. K-9 Unit conducted an extensive area search of the ravine but did not locate the suspects. Officers did however locate suspect vehicle a Toyota Corolla parked in the lot at dealership. The trunk was open and a car jack was inside. The keys were in the ignition and the passenger door was still open. A search of the vehicle Officers located two cell phones and there were several bricks in the back seat. (Gas Station)

On 11/18/2015 victim pulled into the Gas Station in her 2011 Chevy Malibu and went into the gas station briefly. On her way back out of the station and walking to her car, she was approached by 2 black males, one holding/aiming a shotgun at her, demanding that she bring her keys and purse to him, which she complied. She was then ordered to run away, which she did, as the suspects entered into her vehicle and left the scene.

Victim's vehicle was later recovered in front of a residence in Detroit. During the processing of victims vehicle evidence was collected, analyzed, and two suspects was developed.

One of suspects who were on parole for an unrelated crime was located and interviewed by Southfield Detectives.

The suspect made admissions that he was involved in the Car Jacking incident in Southfield back on 11/18/2015.

The suspect was taken into custody for Armed Robbery (Car Jacking) processed and lodged.

2-29722 Farmbrook Villa (Attempt Only)
(Residential- Condo's)

All Four Wheel Locks were taken from 2016 GMC Yukon. Appears to be an Attempt LFA.

3-28000 Block of Telegraph Rd. (11:00pm- 7:00am)
(Car Dealership)

Suspects attacked Four Chevy Corvettes outside the business under the front overhang and stole All Four Wheels & Tires from each vehicle. Suspects also broke out a 4'x 10' Double Window to gain access to the front showroom.

Once inside the show room suspects stole All Four Wheels & Tires from a Z06 Corvette in the showroom.

All of the wheels had one wheel lock on them which was removed. The outside vehicles were left on wooden blocks the Z06 in the showroom was dropped on the tile showroom floor after the wheels were taken.

Possession of Heroin-

2- Arrests

Officers made traffic stop for traffic violation.

Prior to the stop the passenger in vehicle was making furtive movements like he was hiding something.

Investigation led to officers observing in plain view between the center console and passenger seat what appeared to be narcotics paraphernalia.

A K-9 Unit was called to scene and conducted narcotics sweep of vehicle. After the sweep was completed Officers recovered suspected Heroin from the vehicles interior.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample the suspected Heroin. The result was positive for possible presence of Heroin.

Both occupants of the vehicle were arrested for Possession of Heroin.

Officers were dispatched to location reference call from Bus Driver.

The driver states vehicle has been following the bus. Male driver waving arms at bus driver and driving crazy behind him.

Officer located vehicle and attempted to stop the vehicle.

After activating overheads and telling driver to pull over to the right the driver of vehicle fled from Officer.

The suspect vehicle fled west on Civic Center to Northwestern Hwy where it got caught up in heavy traffic.

Another Southfield Officer assisted original Officer and together they boxed the vehicle in and were able to stop the vehicle.

The driver was taken into custody for Fleeing & Eluding.

Officers were dispatched to suspicious vehicle stuck in the backyard of residence.

Officers located vehicle, the driver was passed out behind the wheel and the vehicle was running.

Officers illuminated the inside of the vehicle with a flashlight and observed a handgun sticking out from under the driver's right leg.

Officers were called to location (School) on report from Asst. Principal that they were investigating student in possession of several Prescription Pills.

Investigation revealed that student was suspected of setting off several "Stink Bombs" inside the school.

When searching the students Back Pack several non-prescribed Prescription Pills were located inside the students back pack.

There were also several Gift Cards/ Debit Cards not belonging to the student located in the back pack.

Officer's investigation led to the arrest of student for Possession of Prescription Medication w/o Prescription.

The Gift Cards and Bank Cards were confiscated and that part of incident is still under investigation.

Resisting/ Disorderly/ Trespassing-

1- Arrest

04/15/2016 3:48pm

24000 Block of Lahser Rd

(Southfield School)

Officer was called to assist Principal and Security with a former student that was currently trespassing at the campus.

The student is currently enrolled at another Southfield School, has been warned in the past and has no business at this school.

Investigation revealed that former student attempted several times to enter SHS. Each time he was advised by Security to leave the campus. The former student made threats towards security and refused to leave campus. During the incident with security there were approx. 20- 30 students that witnessed incident and it created a school disturbance.

When Officer arrived and attempted to make contact with former student he ignored Officer and continued to make a scene in front of other students. (Creating School Disturbance)

Officer called for backup and a second Southfield Officer arrived on scene.

When Officers advised former student that he was under arrest for Trespassing and Causing a School Disturbance he resisted arrest. The former student was eventually taken into custody and conveyed to Southfield Jail.

A&B/ Resisting Officer/ Disorderly Person- 2- Arrests

04/17/2016 1:00am

16000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd.

(Hospital)

Officers were at Hospital for unrelated matter when they were summoned by hospital personnel needing assistance with two disorderly females in the Emergency Room (ER).

Investigation revealed that one of the two females was in (ER) for treatment of a cut over her left eye sustained when hit with a lamp by her boyfriend. (Possibly occurred in Detroit)

When victim was advised by hospital staff that she needed to be moved to a different treatment area due a more serious medical emergency coming into the (ER) she got upset.

After being moved a confrontation between the two females and hospital staff ensued. Both females became disorderly and threats were made towards hospital staff. Security had to be called.

As security was escorting both females out of the hospital one of the females picked up full roll of medical tape and threw it at one of the nurse's striking her in the head. The nurse received a laceration to her scalp that was approximately 2 inches long.

It was determined that both females would be arrested for Disorderly Conduct and A&B.

When Officers attempted to take both subjects into custody one of the females resisted arrest and assaulted an Officer.

Both females were eventually taken into custody and lodged at Southfield Jail.

Felony-False Police Report/ Misrepresentation/ Southfield
Warrant 1-Arrest

20000 Block of W Nine Mile Rd.

On 04/17/2016 at 11:50pm, Officers were dispatched to 20000 Block of Nine Mile for a carjacking that just occurred.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the alleged Carjacking victim. After interviewing victim, he later admitted he was not carjacked, no crime was committed and he gave Officer false information about his identity. Victim was arrested for Felony False Police Report, Misrepresentation, and a Southfield Warrant.
