**Information:**

Over the past few weeks, there have been numerous day time & afternoon Home Invasions in this area.

There is no suspect information at this time but citizens have reported seeing youths that they do not recognize as living in the neighborhood that are sitting in vehicles on the streets and hanging out possibly smoking weed at Simms Park.

Residents should call the police if they see any suspicious activity, vehicles or persons that they observe in this area. (Especially if you see them up near any residence)

Most forced entry into the homes have been by kicking front doors or through unlocked windows.

Residents are reminded not to leave valuables such as jewelry in common areas of their homes.
