Home Invasions Occupied Dwellings

(North of 8 mile, South of 9 mile between Southfield Rd & Lasher Rd.)

There have been 4 Home Invasions in the past two weeks that occurred in the early morning hours of occupied dwellings. The occupants at each residence were awakened by loud noises from the suspect attempting to break in.

Details of each incident are listed below.

OUIIN/ Possession of Heroin- 1- Arrest

Officers were dispatched to assist the Fire Department with a slumped subject.

Once on scene Officers observed a Purple Cadillac off the roadway on the grass in a residential area. Officers were advised by Fire Department that the driver was unconscious when they arrived. Officers observed a hypodermic needle next to the driver and three small packages of suspected heroin on the front passenger's seat. Officer's investigation led to the arrest of subject for OUIIN and a Blood Draw was later taken from subject at the hospital.

The suspected Heroin was Field tested by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician. The result was positive for possible presence of Heroin. Suspect was lodged for Operating under influence of Narcotics/ Possession of Heroin.
