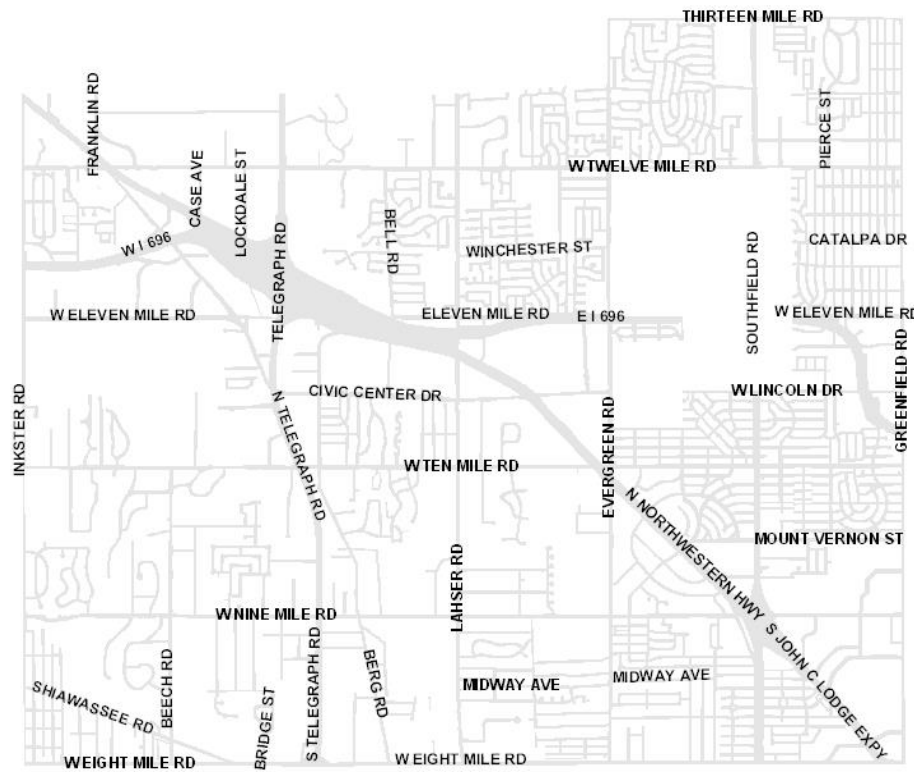

The crime occurred at about 4:00am this morning.</p> <p>The suspect was a B/M about 30-40 years of age and bald. He appeared to be medium to heavy build; wearing all dark clothing. The video shows the suspect go behind the counter and take money out of the cash registers.</p> <p>The suspect in this case appears to be the same person responsible for other Commercial B&amp;E's in the city. Incident is under investigation.</p>

Suspect used a rock to break out the window, entered the Café and stole the cash till with an undisclosed amount of money. Suspect fled the scene and drove east on 9 Mile Rd. at approx. 3:46am. Suspect vehicle appears to be a 98-99 White Buick 4-dr with possibly a different color 2-3 inch door molding. The suspect vehicle is believed to be a Buick Road Master or a Cadillac of that vintage. The suspect vehicle in this case appears to be the vehicle responsible for several other Commercial B&amp;E's in the city.</p>

Victim then left to phone the police.</p> <p>Victim states she broke up with her ex-boyfriend approx. a year ago, but he stays at her apartment frequently. Maintenance was notified and repaired victims door at approx. 3:30pm this date.</p> <p>Victim left her apartment and returned back to her apartment at 7:15pm and observed her apartment door forced open again. (worse than the first time) Victim advised that the few belongings that her ex-boyfriend had in the apartment were gone.</p> <p>Some of victim's items were also missing from the apartment.</p> <p>Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

She noticed that there was also another subject outside smoking.</p> <p>After she was done, she went back into the building. The subject followed her inside.</p> <p>The subject then pulled out a knife and pointed it at victim. He threatened to kill victim and told her to take him to her room.</p> <p>The suspect kept the knife by his side as they walked to her room. The suspect told victim he was going to kill her multiple times if she didn't do what he wanted.</p> <p>Once they got to victims room suspect went through all of her belongs looking for money.</p> <p>Victim told him she didn't have any money.</p> <p>When the suspect couldn't find any money, he took her phone. He stated he would return the phone once he has left the building. When he left, he gave her back the phone.</p> <p>The Day Time Hotel Manager for the hotel when being informed of incident involving patron stated that the suspect matched the description of a subject that stole his night manager's cell phone earlier that morning.</p> <p>Information was developed that the suspect left</p>

			<p>the hotel in a White 1999-2003 Nissan Maxima 4-Door.</p> <p>When Officers interviewed victim from original complaint it became apparent that the victim wasn't being totally honest and telling the truth about what really happened and why she was at the hotel.</p> <p>It appears that the victim in the original incident was a prostitute. When searching her room several condom wrappers were located on the nightstand and in the garbage.</p> <p>When the victim realized that Officers were suspicious as to why she was at the hotel she became uncooperative.</p> <p>It still appears that some type of Robbery occurred and a report was initiated.</p>

Victim states he went to a residence in the 18000 Block of George Washington to visit with a female class mate to discuss a class project. When the female's parents and brother came home and discovered victim in her bedroom victim fled out the bedroom window. The female's brother gave chase and caught up to victim and assaulted him numerous times. The brother then left and went back home. The parents then came and got victim and brought him back to their house. Once back at the house the victim states the mother told her son to beat victim up again. The son started hitting victim again and then the mother started hitting victim with a cane. During this assault the son took victims I-Phone 6 Cell Phone from his pocket. The mother and father then took victim home to his house and informed his parents that they caught him in their house with their daughter. The suspects deny assaulting victim or taking his cell phone. Evidence suggests otherwise as victim had several obvious injuries throughout his body. The cane that was used to assault victim and victims cell phone were not located at this time. The female from residence was interviewed and she stated that she did voluntarily invite victim into her residence and never made mention of any wrong doing by victim.

The husband alleges that he feared for his life and he drew his handgun and fired one round at the vehicle. The driver of vehicle was vague and deceptive when questioned about where he had come from and where he was going. Officer advised driver on traffic offense and cleared the traffic stop. At approx. 9:00pm Officers again observed same vehicle and driver S/B on Southfield Service Dr. N/of 8 Mile Rd. Officers followed vehicle to a residence just south of 8 Mile Rd in Detroit. The vehicle was at the residence for a short period of time and was then followed back into Southfield where it was stopped for traffic offense. During the stop the driver was questioned why he was at the residence in Detroit. He stated he was looking for his girlfriend at that Crack House. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected Crack Cocaine. The result was positive for possible presence of Cocaine. The W/M driver was arrested for Possession of Cocaine.</p>

Officers were dispatched to location on report of a subject with a knife making threats towards a female.

Victim states she was outside in the Plaza and observed suspect walking towards her. As he was walking towards her he made some type of verbal threat. The suspect then pulled out a pocket knife opened it and said "do something, I dare you."

Victim went back inside store and notified employees to call the police.

Employee in the store stated suspect made her feel uncomfortable by the way he was looking at her and speaking to her. She stated suspect kept leaning over the counter and made a statement to her with sexual overtones.

Officers arrived on scene, investigated incident and the suspect has been identified.

Officers stopped vehicle for traffic violations W/B 8 Mile west of Stahelin.

During the stop officers observed furtive movements by the driver and when approaching the vehicle noticed that the driver had taken his shoes off.

The two W/M occupants stated they were in the area from Shelby Twsp. to get a Coney Island? Both subjects were very nervous when questioned why they would drive so far for a Coney Island.

The driver of the vehicle gave Officers consent to search the vehicle. When the passenger exited the vehicle Officers immediately observed suspected plastic baggies with suspected cocaine on seat where passenger was sitting.

The driver was asked if he had any cocaine on him. He stated he had a little in his pocket. He then gave Officers one plastic baggie with suspected cocaine from his pocket.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested samples from baggies with suspected cocaine.

The result was positive for possible presence of cocaine on all three tests.

Both subjects were taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine.

28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy

(Commercial Bar Establishment)

Officers were conducting a property inspection at Bar Establishment in the 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy, due to recent illegal drug use, drinking in the parking lot and weapons offenses.

Officers located a vehicle that was double parked and occupied by five subjects. Officers activated and pointed their spot light at the vehicle. All of the occupants of the vehicle immediately attempted to exit the vehicle. Officers observed an extreme amount of smoke coming from the interior of the vehicle.

The occupants were advised to stay in the vehicle. They complied. Officer's investigation revealed that none of the occupants had a Medical Marijuana Card.

The occupants stated they had bought the marijuana from someone at Bar, they smoked it all and there wasn't any more marijuana in the vehicle.

All subjects were asked out of the vehicle. Officers conducted the search of the vehicle, upon the search; Officers located two handguns in the vehicle. One of the firearms was reported stolen.

There was also suspected marijuana recovered from suspects and the interior of the vehicle.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested a sample of the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

All Five occupants in the vehicle were taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana/ CCW/ Possession of Stolen Handgun.
