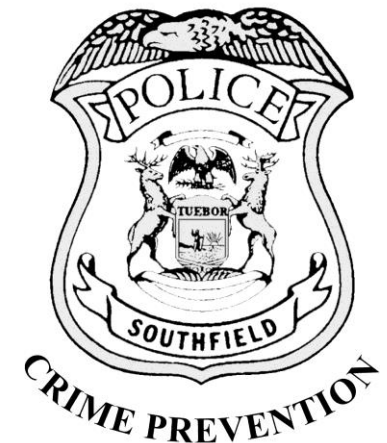

## Commercial Burglaries:

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
From: 08/07/2016 7:00pm To: 08/08/2016 4:15am	28000 Northwestern (Commercial- Cleaners)	Front Door was smashed out.	Victim states unknown suspect(s) smashed out the glass door and took a petty cash envelope kept under the front counter. An undisclosed amount of cash was taken.
From: 08/06/2016 6:30am To: 08/06/2016 8:00am	18000 W Thirteen Mile (Commercial- Lab)	A key was used for entry.	R/P representative for business states that this morning a vendor arrived to find the front door to business standing open. After reviewing surveillance video he identified a white male in his 60's that had entered the suite and remained inside for only about 3 minutes. The male entered through the rear door with a key. He then walked through the suite and out the front door leaving it standing open. A minute or so later the suspect returned through the front door and went to the rear door pulling it shut & securing it. It appears that he had something in his hand about the size of a book. He then leaves again through the front door without the object, and again left the front door standing open.

08/01/2016 6:33pm	28000 Stuart Ave.	Rear door was attempted. Entry was through large window adjacent to the rear door.	R/P states that she arrived at her father in-law's home to check on it and saw the back door kicked in and glass on the ground. R/P advises incident occurred sometime between 10:00pm and the following day when she discovered someone forced entry into residence and took several items. (6:33pm) R/P advised there were a Computer System, Cell Phone, Printer and a Microwave taken.
From: 08/01/2016 3:30am To: 08/01/2016 4:45am (Larceny From Auto Also)	23000 Sargent Ave.	Unknown on how entry was made into the garage.	Victim advises he went out to his truck and discovered several items had been stolen from the vehicle. Further investigation by victim after looking at his surveillance video discovered the following: Motion detectors went off at 3:30am. The video then shows a suspect walking up to his vehicle and the light inside the vehicle going off. At 4:45am the video shows the suspect going from the truck and his garage taking items. He then sees a truck pull onto his neighbor's lawn. The suspect then takes several items and puts them on his neighbor's lawn by the truck. A few minutes later, the video shows the suspect(s) driving away in what looked like a dark colored early 90's Ford F-150 towards Berg from Sargent. Victim described one of the suspects as a male, 5'-9", thin, and 130-140 lbs. Several tools were taken from both the garage and victims truck.

Possession of Cocaine/ Heroin/ Marijuana- 1- Arrest

Greenfield Rd. & W Ten Mile Rd.  
Officers stopped vehicle for several Traffic Violations. After stopping  
the vehicle Officers observed furtive movements from the lone  
passenger in the vehicle.  
After approaching the vehicle the lone passenger continued his furtive  
movements. Officers asked occupants if there were any weapons in  
the vehicle. The lone passenger stated yes. The passenger was  
removed from the vehicle. A search of the passenger recovered a knife  
and suspected cocaine, heroin and marijuana.  
A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected  
substances.  
The result of the 3- separate Field Tests resulted in possible presence  
of Cocaine, Heroin and Marijuana.  
The passenger was arrested for Possession of Cocaine, Heroin &  
Marijuana.

**Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles  
How to prevent this from happening to you!**

- Citizens should never leave anything of value inside  
their vehicle.
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in  
the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the  
wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle,  
especially the center console or glove box. This is the  
first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle  
as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Keep in mind, in most instances when someone breaks out a window or is attempting to take Wheels & Tires from a vehicle it will emit a loud noise and a loud boom when dropping vehicle to the ground after removing the Wheels & Tires from a vehicle.
