


Victim was walking home to his apartment on Sherman St. after he got off work when he observed a Smaller Red or Burgundy P.U., that he thought was an early 2000's Model Dodge Dakota, good condition, no cover on the back bed, regular wheels and tinted windows, pull left wheels to curb at S/B Berg and Eight Mile. Suspect got out of the driver's seat. He was a B/M, 40's, 6-0, medium build, clean cut with a short beard, wearing a black/gray jogging suit, black shoes, black gloves. The suspect approached the victim and told him to give him his money. When the victim told the suspect that he did not have any he was struck in the head by suspect with a handgun causing him to fall to the ground. During a brief struggle, the victim gave up a few dollars and an insulated lunch box, purple/black, that contained his mobile cell phone, a cordless Drill, and a Flashlight. While still on the ground, the suspect fired one shot at the victim, striking him in the back. Victim was able to run across Eight Mile to the Gas Station to ask for help. Victim was transported to hospital with what appears to be non- life threatening injuries.

08/16/2016 4:49pm	22000 Negaunee	Attempt Purse Snatching.	Officers responded to the area of Indian & Shiawassee for an Attempted Purse Snatching that had just occurred. Victim advised that she pulled into her driveway in the 22000 Block of Negaunee. Victim states she observed two white males approaching her vehicle from the rear. Victim observed them from her rear view mirror. The males had pulled their shirts up over their faces. Victim states that the shorter subject with curly brown hair approached her door and said "I'm gonna need your purse." Victim replied "No!" The suspect then said "please". Victim then began honking her horn repeatedly to get the attention of her son who was in the house. Victim states that when her son came out the two male suspects fled on foot. The suspects were last observed running south across Shiawassee into the backyards between Indian and Negaunee. Southfield Officers who responded into the area located one of the suspects. The suspect attempted to flee from Officers, jumping several fences going from yard to yard. The suspect was holding his waistband and at one point Officers saw what they believed to be a handgun in suspect's possession. The suspect was taken into custody a short time

later hiding under a truck. A Southfield Police K-9 Unit and other Officers conducted a search for possible weapon that was observed in suspect's possession. A short time later Officers located a handgun matching the description that suspect was observed carrying under a bush in a yard that suspect traveled through while being chased by Police. Officers also located the second suspect. He was observed forcing open a garage door and crawling under the door in the 20000 Block of Indian St. Officers ordered the subject out of the garage. Subject then started to crawl out of the garage and advised he was armed with a knife which he removed from his crotch area and tossed out. Subject was then taken into custody w/o incident. -Good to get these two dangerous criminals off the street. -Great job by all of the Southfield Officers involved in this Investigation & Arrests.

Officers were dispatched to the 29000 Block of Woodcrest Ct. on an unwanted person.

R/P stated he went out to dinner with his girlfriend. When they got back to his house his girlfriend was intoxicated and became irate. R/P asked her to leave and she refused.

Officers located unwanted subject and she was advised on trespassing by her boyfriend and asked to leave. She continued to refuse to leave and was taken into custody for trespassing. The female then gave Officers an alias name. She was also charged with Obstruction. Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
