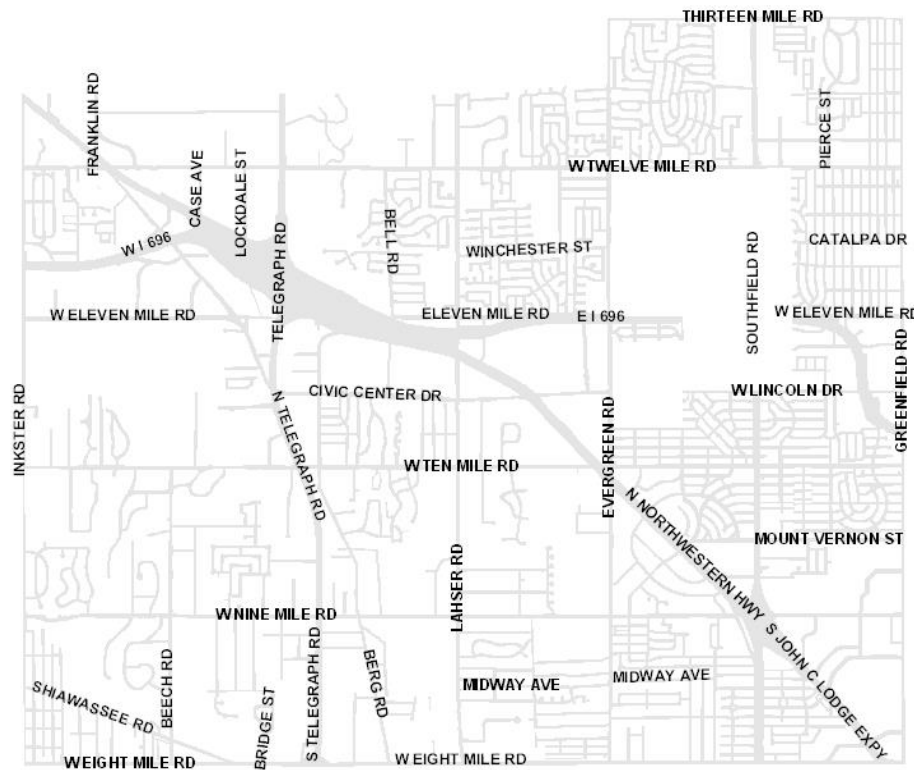

They were In the back (northwest) lot.</p> <p>When Officers arrived and attempted to block the vehicle in the suspects drove forward driving through the bushes to avoid capture.</p> <p>The suspects continued to flee attempting to exit complex and deliberately struck police vehicle that was blocking the entrance.</p> <p>The impact activated the patrol vehicles air bags and Officers sustained injuries.</p> <p>After impact the driver of the vehicle fled on foot. The passenger was immediately taken into custody.</p> <p>The suspect that fled on foot was later taken into custody as he attempted to flee across M-10.</p> <p>Both suspects were arrested for LFA.</p> <p>One of the suspects was a Juvenile and was later released to his parents.</p>

She walked over to the table where victim and her family were sitting. Suspect removed the purse from the back of the chair.</p> <p>Suspect immediately walked to the restroom carrying the purse. Within seconds, suspect emerged from the restroom without the purse.</p> <p>Prior to talking with the suspect, Detectives interviewed other witnesses.</p> <p>Additional incriminating evidence was gathered pointing to this employee as the suspect.</p> <p>Based on the video and witness statements the employee suspect was arrested for Larceny From Building.</p>
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			<p>Suspect was later interviewed by Detectives and suspect made admissions to taking the purse. After taking the purse she went through it and located a credit card and then gave the credit card information to her husband.</p> <p>Detectives went to the suspect's house and located and spoke with the original suspect's husband. Suspect's husband made admissions that he used the credit card to make several purchases on E-Bay using his Pay Pal Account.</p> <p>Several items of merchandise the husband had purchased were recovered from the residence.</p>

- ❖ Ensure your vehicle is locked at all times and valuables are out of sight.
- ❖ Thieves wait for the right time and will move quickly
- ❖ Even if playing sports at a park ensure your vehicle is locked
