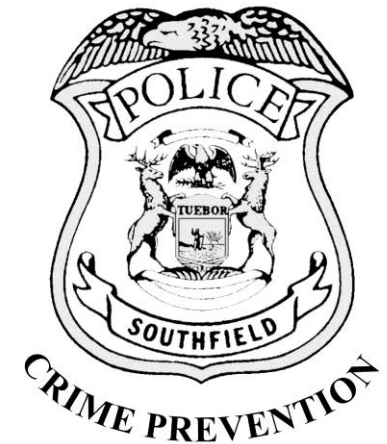
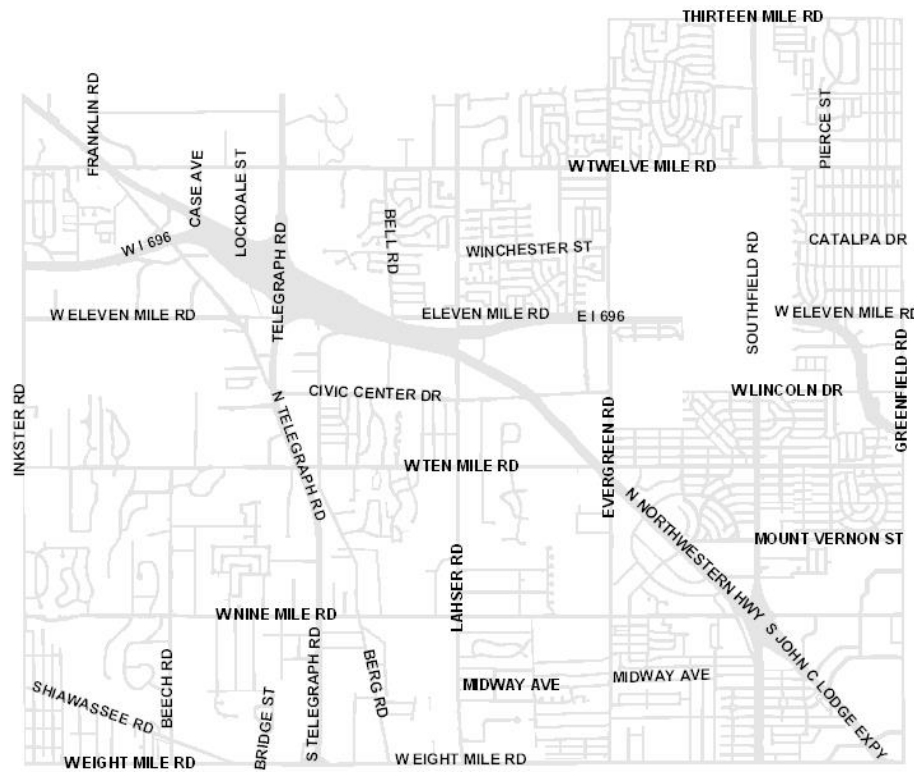

Several items missing from the residence.</p> <p>Victim returned home and together with Officers they reviewed surveillance video of incident.</p> <p>Video showed a Dark SUV park in front of the residence at approx.12:46am.</p> <p>2- B/M's exit the vehicle and go to the front door.</p> <p>Suspect #1, B/M wearing a light colored hoodie and shorts, throws his body & shoulder against the front door, forcibly opening it.</p> <p>Suspect #2, B/M wearing a light colored hoodie and dark sweatpants, entered the home directly after the door was forced open.</p> <p>The suspects are seen taking several items from the residence out to their vehicle. Officer's investigation revealed that the suspect didn't work for Sprinkler Company and wasn't authorized to be at the site or to take any scrap metal from the site.

Officers also recovered several brand new metal items (not scrap) from suspect's vehicle.
