



Special Attention:

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier. How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages.

Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package.

Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Reckless Driving/ Possession of a Weapon in Jail/ R&O- 1- Arrest 08/27/2018 8:27am

25000 Block of W Eight Mile Rd.

Officers were dispatched to the 25000 Block of W Eight Mile Rd regarding a White Chevrolet Cavalier doing burn outs in the parking lot. Officers located the vehicle and subject parked in the parking lot. Officers spoke to the witnesses and suspect.

The suspect made admissions to doing burn outs in the parking lot because he was bored.

The suspect was taken into custody for Reckless driving and his vehicle was impounded.

After being processed, jail personnel located a knife blade on the suspect. When it came time for suspect to be arraigned on his charges he refused to remove himself from his cell for video arraignment. The suspect had to be handcuffed and forced into a wheelchair. He resisted Detectives that responded to the jail to assist.
