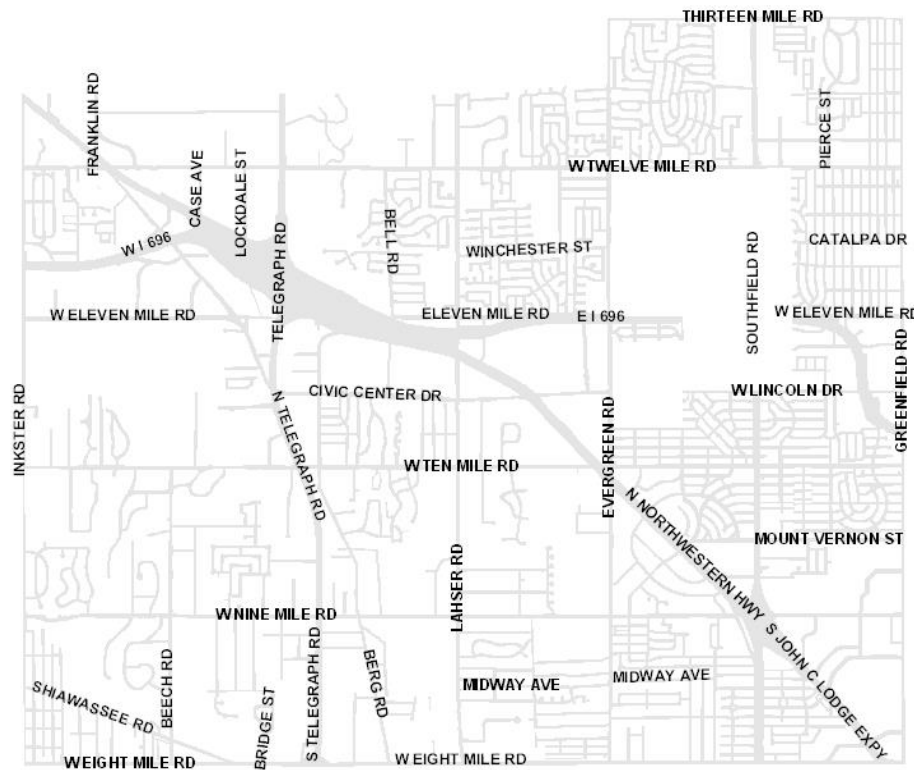

Date/Time	Address (block range)	Method of Entry	Description/Suspect Information
12/15/2015 4:11am	23000 Lahser Rd. (Commercial Cell Phone)	Front door glass was broken out.	<p>Officers responded to alarm at business. Officers discovered front door glass was broken out. It doesn't appear that entry was gained into the business.</p> <p>Business owner arrived on scene and advised that nothing was missing from the business.</p> <p>Surveillance video showed the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-A silver or light colored Ford Explorer arrived in the parking lot and drove along the south wall of the business.-Two subjects walk to the rear of the business and walk north. <p>They are described as follows:</p> <p>Suspect#1- U/M, 20, average height/weight, wearing a baseball cap, North Face coat, and dark pants with reflective material on the knee caps. This subject was carrying a crowbar.</p> <p>Suspect#2- U/F, 20, smaller than Suspect#1, was wearing a North Face Coat.</p> <p>-Approximately 6 minutes later, the subjects walk back south then east along the south wall to the southeast corner of the building.</p> <p>The male subject breaks the door glass with a crowbar and both subjects immediately run from the scene westbound from the store.</p>

(Commercial- Electric)</p>	<p>Padlocks were pried and one lockset was drilled out.</p>	<p>Victim reports that sometime over the weekend while the business was closed unknown suspect(s) climbed over the fence/gate into the rear lot of business. Suspect(s) then went into several unlocked trailers, and broke into 4 others by prying the padlocks off and drilling one lockset out. Victim does not know if anything was actually stolen.</p>

12/14/2015 7:19pm	20000 Indian St.	Rear Door was forced.	<p>Victim advises residence is under renovation. Sometime over the last 24 Hours someone forced entry into the residence and stole several items. On 12/17/2014, three days later, victim was putting his garbage out and observed some of the items that were taken from his house in the neighbor's garbage. The neighbor's residence is a "Group Home". Officers went to this residence and were granted permission to search the residence. Nothing of evidential value was located. The residents at this residence couldn't explain why victim's stolen items were in their garbage. Two possible suspects were identified. Incident is under investigation.</p>

Victim walked toward the door and found suspect, who is known to victim, standing in her dining room. Victim thinks she left her apartment door unlocked (No signs of force). Victim stated suspect was yelling "where is my stuff". Victim replied I don't have any of your stuff and told suspect to get out. Suspect looked around and allegedly choked and hit victim with a curtain rod. Victim attempted to call 911 but suspect took her cell phone. Suspect has been identified and incident is under investigation.</p>

Recently there has been a rash of Larceny of UPS/FedEx Packages in the area of the 28000 Block of Evergreen Rd.

On 12/17/2015 a (witness) provided evidence and information regarding suspect that was suspected of stealing UPS/FedEx packages from resident's porches.

An investigation ensued and a search warrant was obtained for a residence in Southfield.

On December 22, 2015 Southfield Officers & Detectives arrived at suspect's residence to execute the search warrant.

Prior to executing search warrant the suspect exited the residence. The suspect made admissions that he had stolen UPS/FedEx packages from a couple residences in Southfield.

Detectives executed search warrant and additional evidence was recovered from residence.

Officers and Detectives were able to establish that the suspect was responsible for many more Larceny of Packages in the area than the ones he admitted too.

Suspect was arrested for numerous counts of Larceny of UPS/FedEx Packages.
