


K-9 Officer immediately gave an additional K-9 announcement and ordered the suspect to come out. A W/M matching the description of suspect from earlier B&E at a church stepped out of the room and was ordered to the floor. The suspect complied and was taken into custody w/o incident. The suspect was later interviewed by Detectives and he made admissions to the B&E at the church and the

			B&E of several offices within the building he was apprehended. Suspect was processed and lodged at the Southfield Jail.

Special Attention: Home Invasions

There were two Home Invasions this past week at the Apartment Complex in the 25000 Block of W. Eight Mile Rd.

Both incidents appear to be daytime Home Invasions.

1) 25000 Block of W Eight Mile Rd.

Victim states sometime between 12:00pm- 4:00pm someone forced entry into her apartment by prying open the hallway door.

TV and a Firestick are missing from the apartment.

Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier. How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

Assault with Intent to Murder:

22000 Block of Lake Ravines Dr.

B/M suspect was at a residence in the 22000 Block of Lake Ravines acting irrational. The homeowners, who did not know who the B/M was, called the police to report this incident giving the description of the male and his vehicle. Officers arrived to find the suspicious person had left. A short time later another call came in from another residence on Lake Ravines reporting the same suspicious person was there. Officers found the vehicle with the male driving. A female witness was flagging down Officers pointing to another female stating, "she is shot". Another female approached who had an apparent gunshot wound. The female was taken to the hospital for treatment and the male was taken into custody.

Detectives were called in and the investigation is ongoing.

Special Attention: Crime Prevention Tip's for the Holidays!

With the Holidays approaching citizens should be extra careful when shopping. Citizens should never leave anything of value inside the compartment area of their vehicle. If you must leave valuables in the car be sure to put them in the trunk. If you don't have a trunk then I would recommend you take items home.

Women should be extra careful when carrying a purse. Don't ever carry your purse over your shoulder and don't ever leave your purse in a shopping cart unattended. You are an easy target for someone to take your purse or take your wallet from your purse.

I would recommend that citizens not carry a purse; instead they should carry a wallet or something that can be concealed from thieves.

OWI/ CCW/ Possession of Marijuana/

No License Never Applied- 1- Arrest

Officer observed vehicle commit several traffic violations.

After following vehicle onto S/B M-10 the vehicle accelerated up to speeds above the posted speed limit. The vehicle was also observed weaving in and out of its lane.

Officer initiated a traffic stop. The vehicle was very slow to stop. The vehicle eventually pulled over onto the right shoulder just before the S/B M-39 entrance ramp.

After approaching vehicle Officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle, there were ashes on the driver's lap, and there was a plastic baggie w/ suspected marijuana in plain view on the floorboard between the driver's legs.

The driver didn't have a valid driver's license. He was given several sobriety tests to perform and was given a PBT.

(Preliminary Breath Test) The result of the PBT was over the legal limit. Officers recovered the suspected marijuana and also recovered a Stun Gun from the glovebox.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana. The driver was taken into custody for OWI/ CCW/ Possession of Marijuana/ No License Never Applied.

The driver refused a Breath Test. A search warrant for a blood draw was secured and completed.

Assault with Intent to Murder- 1- Arrest

American Dr. & W Eleven Mile Rd.

(Pebble Creek Park)

Officers were dispatched to Hospital regarding subject that was possibly stabbed in Southfield.

Investigation revealed that victim and his friend had met with two females on the Tender Website. (Escort Service)

The four subjects met and drove around Southfield, smoked some weed and drank before finally ending up at Pebble Creek Park.

Victim was in the back seat with suspect when she stabbed victim with a pocket knife. Suspect then fled the vehicle and ran into the woods.

Victim and his friend immediately drove to the hospital for treatment. The two females were later located and interviewed.

The female that stabbed victim was taken into custody for Assault with Intent to Murder.

Southfield Detectives were called in and Incident is under investigation.
