**Special Attention: Retail Fraud Suspect/
Suspect Vehicle Information:**

The suspect(s) and suspect vehicle description were gathered from three separate Retail Fraud Cases. The suspects are described as 3- B/M's in their early 20's (one with shoulder length braids) and a W/F 18-20 yoa, 5'-4", thin – 110lbs.

The suspects are driving what is believed to be a 2005 Gold Pontiac Grand Am 4- door however on one of the incidents the vehicle was described as a Grand Prix. The vehicle also is said to have damage to the driver side tail light. (small white light to rear).

All items stolen in each case were folded and stacked on display tables near the front door. The suspects entered business, distracted employees to another area of the store while the suspects would run out with stacks of expensive clothing including Hoodie's and Sweatpants.
