A third suspect stayed in the vehicle in the driver's seat. Suspects attempted to pry the door and eventually broke out the glass of the door. Suspects were not able to make entry into the business and left the scene at 3:13am in the Hyundai.

<p><b>Special Attention: "Shooting"</b>  Northwestern Hwy. &amp; W Twelve Mile Rd.  12/28/2017 10:40pm  On 12/28/2017 Officers were dispatched to Northwestern and 12 Mile for a report of a shooting. Officers met with R/P (victim) who advised that she was taking her property out of a house in Detroit because she was moving. There was an altercation about what items victim was taking from the house which resulted in shots being fired at their Truck after leaving the house. This incident occurred in Detroit and victim filed a police report with DPD and started heading home.  Victim and her cousins who were helping her move we're driving on N/B M-10 in Southfield. Victim noticed a white car was following them from the house, pulled up next to them on M-10 south of the Lahser Rd. and shot at them 3 times.  Victim identified the shooter as someone that she knows. Suspect was sitting in the front passenger side of the vehicle. She said that she saw his face and knows who he is. Victim states that suspect is the same one who shot at them in Detroit.  Victim described suspect as a B/M, 6', thin build, black hoodie, black pants, short hair and possible short facial hair. Victim saw a black handgun.
