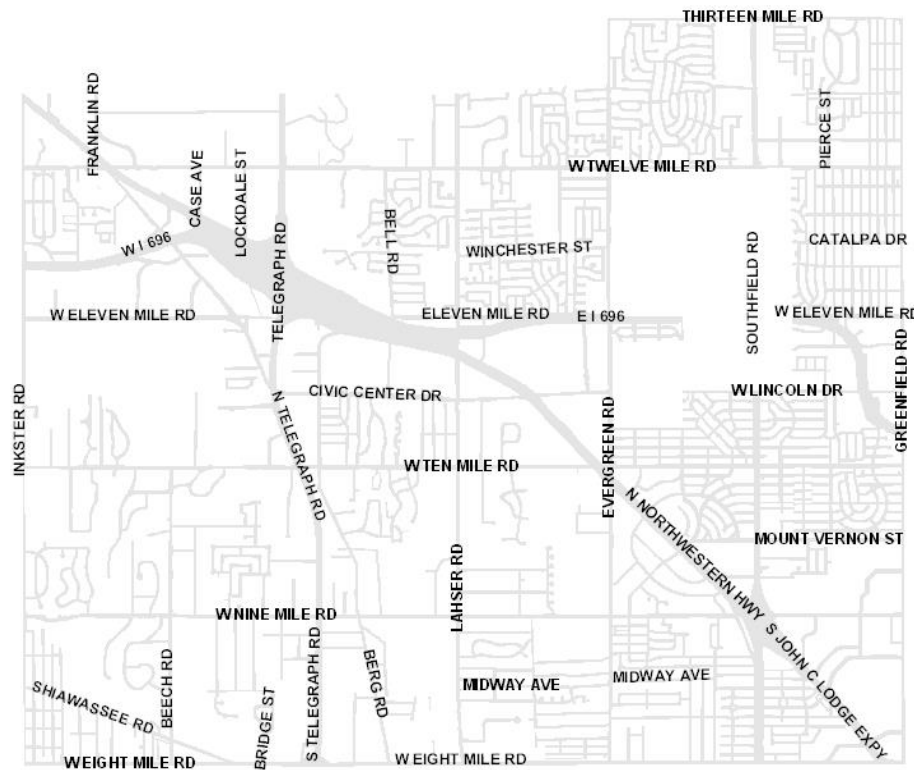

**Home Invasion- Cold Case From 2011**

1- Suspect has been positively identified and charges are pending.

Incident occurred:

On 06/11/2011 Officers responded to Home Invasion in progress.

Officers arrived on scene and discovered good Home Invasion.

Suspect(s) were scared off by Homeowners who were home at the time of incident.

The suspect(s) were not located at this time.

A Southfield Police Evidence technician processed the scene and discovered fresh blood on a broken section of deck railing. Samples of the blood were taken as evidence.

The blood was later tested for DNA and at that time there was no identification made.

On 02-01-2016 a search of DNA database again resulted in a match of DNA collected from the scene which was previously submitted from this case.

It was discovered that the suspect was currently incarcerated for another Home Invasion in a Correctional Facility in Michigan.

Southfield Police Detectives secured a Search Warrant to collect a DNA Swab of suspect to verify match of DNA collected from Crime Scene.

On 02/03/2016 Detectives went to the Correctional Facility and met with suspect.

Suspect complied and a DNA Swab was taken from suspect.

After the Swab was taken the suspect made admissions to the Home Invasion back on 06/11/2011.

At this time Detectives are in the process of submitting case to the Oakland County Prosecutors Office.

Officers were dispatched to Accident Investigation.  
During the investigation Officers were informed by Southfield Fire Paramedic that one of the drivers admitted to doing Heroin and he observed a needle on the center console of the driver's vehicle.  
A Southfield Police K-9 Officer and his K-9 were summoned to scene and conducted a sweep of vehicle.  
K-9 alerted on several areas within the vehicle and suspected Cocaine & Heroin were recovered from the vehicle.  
The driver of this vehicle was arrested for OUI/ Possession of Heroin & Cocaine.  
The suspected Heroin & Cocaine were both individually Field Tested by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician.  
The results were positive for possible presence of Heroin & Cocaine.  
Officers transported suspect to hospital for a Blood Draw.

Additional suspected marijuana, a scale, and a large sum of money was also recovered. The driver was arrested for PWID Marijuana. The passenger was arrested for Possession of Marijuana. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.

OUI/DWLS 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense/ Poss. of Cocaine/ Poss. of Marijuana  
1- Arrest  
Officers stopped vehicle for driving erratically and suspected OWI. Officer's investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license, there was suspected loose marijuana and brown rolling papers in between driver's legs, and his speech was slurred. Officers also recovered a ceramic plate with a white powdery substance believed to be Cocaine and a scale.  
The driver made admissions to Officers that he had just taken Cocaine and he was in the process of rolling a blunt at the time Officers pulled him over.  
A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested suspected Marijuana and Cocaine.  
Both tested positive for poss. presence of Marijuana and Cocaine. The driver was arrested and transported to Hospital where a blood draw was obtained.  
The driver was then transported to Southfield Jail and was lodged.

Officers responded to business on Retail Fraud just occurred.

Suspect fled store in a Green Vehicle, possibly a Honda.

A Southfield Officer located the suspect vehicle S/B Telegraph & 9 Mile Rd. The suspect vehicle failed to stop when he attempted to stop the vehicle.

The vehicle fled into a neighboring jurisdiction driving through several residential streets. The pursuit was terminated.

A short time later Officers from the Southfield Police Department went to the registered owner of suspect vehicles address. The suspect vehicle that was earlier chased was located in the driveway.

A subject (later arrested) came out of the house and approached Officers and questioned their presence.

The Officers advised subject why they were there and he denied any involvement in the Retail Fraud or Fleeing & Eluding.

The subject was arrested at this time for Warrant out of 46<sup>th</sup> Dist. Ct. in Southfield for DWLS. (Driving With License Suspended)

After arresting suspect Officers went to the business where Retail Fraud occurred and reviewed their surveillance video and positively identified the suspect that was arrested as the person that committed Retail Fraud.

The suspect was still wearing the same clothing that was observed in store surveillance.
