



On 02/13/2018 Officers were dispatched on a report of an Armed Robbery that just occurred at Nine Mile and Lahser. SUSPECT INFORMATION: Suspect #1: B/M, 6'-0", thin build, 18 years old, with a goatee. Last seen wearing a light grey hoodie with the hood worn. Suspect #2: B/M, 6'-0", thin build, 18 years old, with an afro. Last seen wearing a black hoodie. Victim states he was walking S/B on Lahser to the bus stop from Southfield AT&T High School when he saw both Suspect #1 and #2 get out of an unknown Tan Vehicle that was parked at Townhouses on Lahser Road. Both suspects approached him and asked him for a lighter. Victim told both suspects that he did not have one and he continued walking S/B on Lahser. The suspects continued following him so he began running south along Lahser. The suspects ran after him, caught up to him and assaulted and robbed him near Duns Scotus St. Victim was struck on the head by Suspect #2 with his fist. Suspect #1 pulled out a handgun and hit victim in the head with the gun. Victim was forced to the ground and Suspect #2 struck him once more in the chest with his fist. The suspects robbed victim of an undisclosed

amount of cash and his cell phone.
Suspects fled on foot.
Officers and dispatch advised the vehicle
involved in the robbery matched the description
of the robbery vehicle from another incident that
occurred in Southfield which was a Dark Colored
Chevrolet Monte Carlo.
Officers who were working the basketball game
at Southfield A&T High School reviewed
surveillance video from the school and observed
the suspects and suspect vehicle leaving the High
School in a Tan Monte Carlo. They got the
License Plate# from the vehicle and put it out to
other officers over the air.
At approx. 9:00pm a Southfield Officer located
suspect vehicle. Additional Officers responded to
Officers location and the vehicle was stopped
w/o incident.
All three occupants in the vehicle were taken into
custody for the Armed Robbery that occurred on
Lahser Rd.
A search of the suspect vehicle recovered an Air
Soft Pistol and a Pepper Spray Canister that was
consistent with the description of the weapons
used in the Robbery that occurred today and
other Robberies that occurred in Southfield.
It's believed that the suspects were also
responsible for a Robbery that occurred at a Mall
in Troy. Items that were taken from victims in
that incident were recovered in the suspect's
vehicle.

Special Attention: Larceny of Packages that were ordered and delivered via Common Carrier. How to prevent this from happening to you!

Recently several citizens have had packages that were delivered to their residences and apartments stolen prior to them retrieving the packages. Citizens can prevent this from happening by scheduling a specific time to have the package delivered and be waiting for the package. Citizen can also schedule the package to be picked up by themselves at the common carrier facility.

R&C Stolen Property/ CCW- 1- Arrest 02/14/2018 3:07am

Northwestern Hwy. & North Park Dr.

Officers were working the area of Nine Mile and Providence when Officer observed a White Dodge Caravan that matched the description of suspect vehicle of the Armed Robbery that took place at a Hotel in Southfield.

Officer observed suspect vehicle enter Apartment Complex on Providence Dr. and it was closely followed by a Black Nissan Rogue. A short time later both vehicles were observed leaving the Apartment Complex at a high rate of speed.

Officer attempted to stop the White Dodge Caravan on Northwestern Service Drive just north of North Park Dr. The vehicle fled N/B on Northwestern from Nine Mile and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit continued for a period and eventually ended up south on M-10 at North Park Dr. The pursuit was terminated. Suspect vehicle was last seen S/B M-10 at Northland Dr. During the pursuit, other Officers kept a close eye on the second vehicle (Black Nissan Rogue) and eventually stopped this vehicle. The stop was made in the area of Northwestern Service Dr. & Civic Center Dr. There were two occupants in the vehicle. The female driver was interviewed and when asked if there were any weapons in the vehicle, she made admissions that there was a handgun between the driver's seat and center console. The driver made admissions that she bought the handgun on the streets and she didn't have a CPL. The handgun was recovered by Officers and ran on Lein. The handgun came back stolen out of Detroit. The driver was arrested for CCW & R&C Stolen Property. When questioned about who the driver was of the vehicle that fled,

Special Attention: LFA's Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box.
This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

-If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without suspect stated she didn't know who was driving but she followed her friend who was in the car to her apartment on Providence Dr. The friend has been identified and further investigation will be conducted as to who rented the rental vehicle that fled from Officers. The passenger that was in the second vehicle was cleared and released at the scene.

Domestic Assault- Attempt Murder-02/14/2018 6:04pm 26000 Block of Creekside Dr.

(Apartments)

Officers responded to location on report of a Family Trouble in progress. Several people are reportedly bleeding inside the apartment and the R/P is being chased by suspect with an axe. Officers arrived on scene and one of the victims (suspects step son) yelled out to Officers to get his step father who was aggressively walking towards Officers and was brandishing a knife. Suspect was approx. 50 feet south of Officers location walking towards them in the parking lot. Officers advised suspect several times to drop the knife and get on the ground. Suspect continued to advance towards Officers and eventually dropped the knife after several more commands. Suspect threw the knife approx. 10' in front of himself and continued to walk towards Officers with his hands clenched into a fist. Officers continued giving suspect commands to stop walking and to get on the ground and he failed to comply.

As he approached the area where he threw the knife, Officers deployed their Taser's and struck suspect.

The suspect was taken into custody and placed in a patrol vehicle.

alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

Further investigation revealed that an argument started over who was going to get the biggest steak for dinner.

The suspect got upset with his Step Daughter and started to strangle her in the kitchen. Witnesses advised that he lifted her off the ground while choking her until she was unconscious.

When the suspect realized that his Step Son was calling the Police he grabbed a knife and an axe and started chasing him. The Step Son made it to his car where the suspect threw the axe at his car. The Police arrived after this and took the suspect into custody.
