


Southfield Officers initiated a Traffic Stop on a vehicle for Defective Equipment.

Special Attention: Fleeing & Eluding Information:

8 Mile Rd & Southfield Rd.

Officers had just cleared a traffic stop and were returning to the city when they observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed running stop signs on N/B Ashton in Detroit.

When the vehicle got to 8 Mile Rd and went E/B it failed to yield to other traffic and nearly caused an accident on 8 Mile Rd.

When Officers attempted to stop the vehicle it fled S/B on Southfield Freeway.

At one point Officers were able to pull up next to the vehicle to see the occupants. There were 3 B/M's in the vehicle. The driver was wearing a gray jacket and had on a stocking cap. The front passenger had on a dark colored hoodie as well as a stocking cap. The right rear passenger also had on a dark colored hoodie with a ski mask on. All occupants attempted to cover their faces while Officers were next to them. The vehicle exited the freeway and then went N/B on the Southfield Fwy. At this point the pursuit was terminated.

As Officers were returning to the city they observed Detroit F.D. out with a vehicle at Southfield Service Dr. and Curtis. The vehicle was the Blue Honda that Officers were pursuing earlier.

The vehicle was up against a fence at the Detroit Fire Department's parking lot. No damage was done to the fence or to any cars in the parking lot.

28000 Block of Telegraph Rd.

Southfield Officers responded to the 28000 Block of Telegraph Rd on report of a vehicle that had just crashed into the doors of business on the north end of the lot closest to 12 Mile Rd.

Officers arrived on scene and determined that the vehicle in question struck a Handicap Sign in the parking lot and then struck a Pillar Post on the business.

A subject was located who appeared to be intoxicated and made statements indicating that he was the driver of the vehicle. There was also a witness from business who identified the same person as the driver. Officers completed their investigation and determined that the driver was intoxicated and shall be arrested for OWI.

When Officers attempted to take the driver into custody he resisted arrest. Officers used the necessary force to affect the arrest.

The vehicle was unoccupied and was impounded by our Department. Incident is under investigation.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

- -Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)
- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.
- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.
- -After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.
- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.
- -If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without

OWI/ CPL Violation- 1- Arrest 02/19/2017 4:31am

W Nine Mile Rd. & Beech Rd.

Southfield Officers were dispatched on a driver slumped behind the wheel at 9 Mile & Beech Rd.

Officers arrived on scene and the driver seemed confused and didn't know where he was. There was also a passenger in the vehicle.
Officer's investigation, sobriety tests and PBT indicated the driver was intoxicated and he was taken into custody for OWI.

Officers also located a loaded handgun under the front seat belonging to the driver. The driver was also charged with the CPL Violation.

alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and suspect vehicles as you can. Stay on the phone with Dispatchers until the Police arrive.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.
