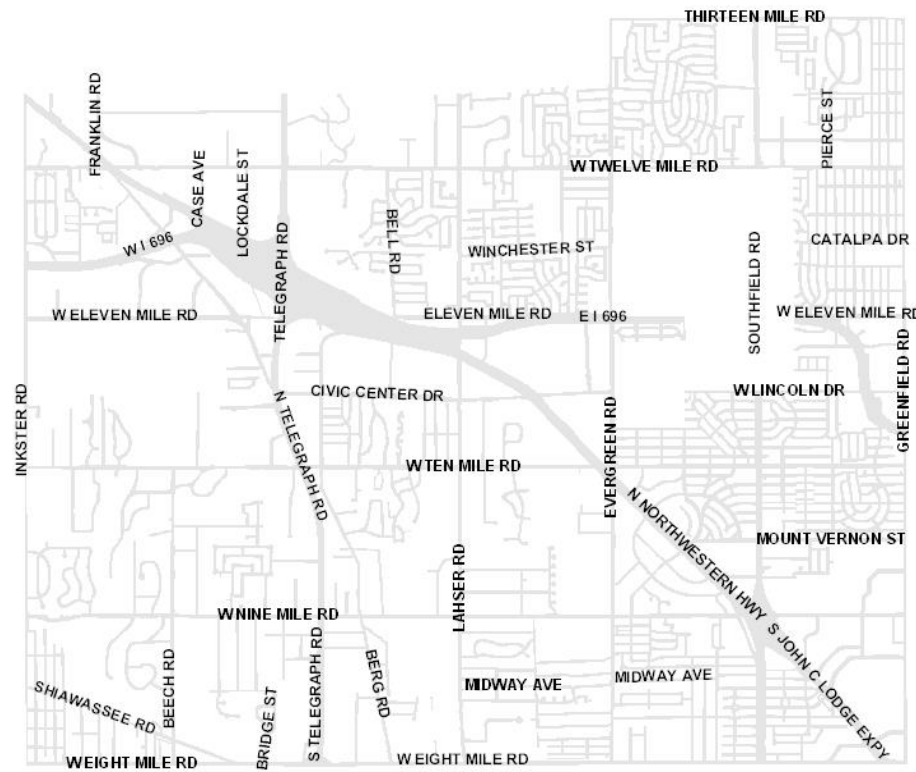

Southfield Officer observed vehicle parked in the Handi Cap Zone with no permit at the Gas Station, 10 Mile & Evergreen Rd.

Officer ran the plate on vehicle and it came back stolen out of neighboring jurisdiction.

Officers stopped the vehicle after it left the Gas Station to investigate.

Investigation revealed that there was narcotics paraphernalia throughout the vehicle and all of the occupants had tracks on their arms and the occupants later admitted to doing Heroin.

There was also a 2 year old child in the vehicle.

Investigation revealed that the vehicle wasn't stolen but was improperly licensed.

One of the passengers lied about his identity and he was arrested for Obstruction and he had numerous Traffic Warrants.

Child Protective Services was contacted in regards to the 2 year olds safety. Representative responded to scene and investigation is ongoing.

Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you hear any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and

Southfield Dispatch put out a broadcast that a Retail Fraud just occurred at store Dispatch advised a Black Saturn left the store E/B on Twelve Mile and the suspects had taken a piece of luggage and concealed several bottles of liquor in it. One of the suspects was detained at the store by Security.

Southfield Officer located the suspect vehicle S/B on Lahser near 11 Mile Rd. When Officers walked up to vehicle it initially looked as though there was just the lone driver in the vehicle. Further inspection revealed that the second suspect from inside the store was lying face down in the back seat on top of the stolen luggage with the stolen liquor bottles.

It was confirmed that this was the second suspect inside the store and he was taken into custody for Retail Fraud.

Officers also responded to the store and met with Security who advised the subject they had detained was also involved in the Retail Fraud. This subject was also taken into custody for Retail Fraud. Security from store also located suspected Crack Cocaine on this suspect. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected cocaine. Result was positive for Possible Presence of Cocaine. This suspect was also charged with Possession of Cocaine. The driver of the suspect vehicle was arrested for DWLS.

-Lots of lighting around the area(s) that you park your vehicles is also very beneficial. Criminals don't like to work in well lighted areas. They prefer to work in darkness because it's difficult to see them.

Officers were traveling N/B M-10 when they observed vehicle traveling over the posted speed limit and exhibiting possible OWI.

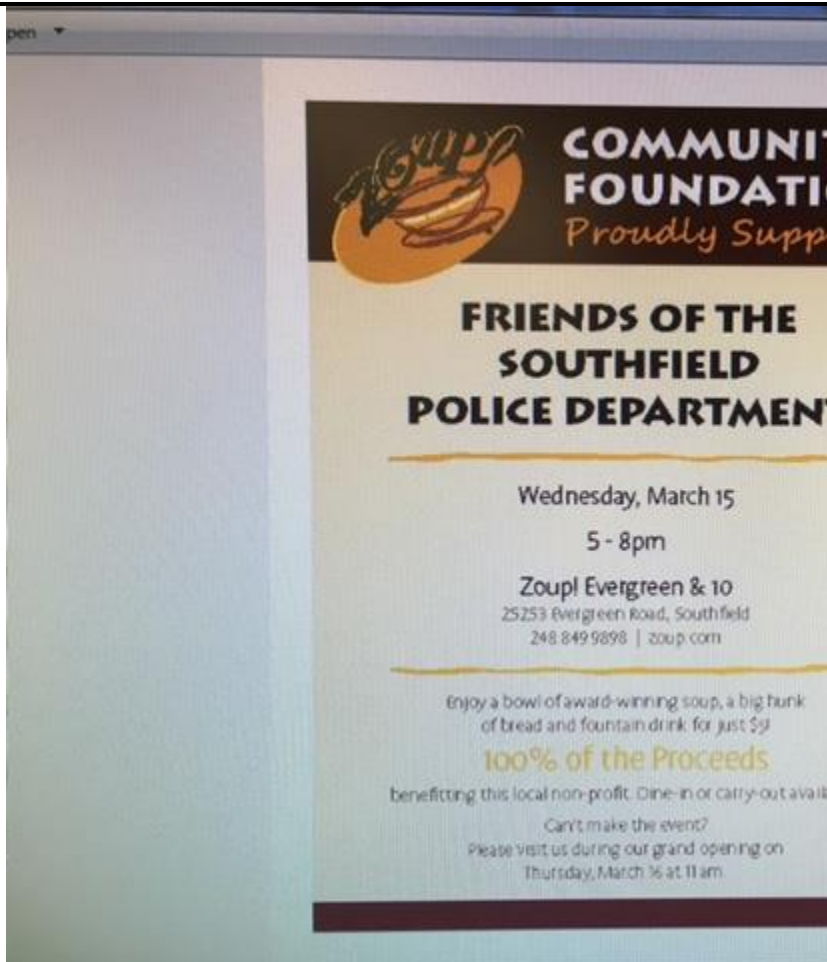
Officers stopped the vehicle and conducted an OWI Investigation.

The driver continued to refuse to get out of his vehicle and had to be extracted from the vehicle.

The driver continued to resist Officers but was eventually handcuffed and taken into custody.

PWID Marijuana- 1- Arrest

Civic Center Dr. & Central Park Blvd.

Southfield Officer stopped vehicle for traffic violation. (Front tinted window) After stopping and approaching the vehicle Officer detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

Additional Officers arrived to assist including a K-9 Unit. The driver consented to a search of his person. Suspected marijuana was recovered from both of the driver's socks and up his right pant leg. K-9 conducted a narcotics sweep of the vehicle and alerted on several areas within the interior of the vehicle. Officers discovered more suspected marijuana, a scale, and numerous clear empty plastic bags commonly seen in narcotics distribution.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician did a Field Test of a sample of suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana.
