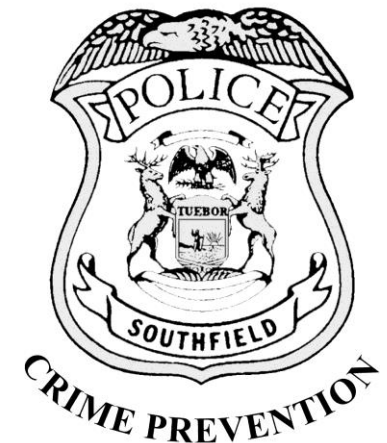

Video evidence showed an Older Model White Buick LeSabre or Park Avenue pull into the parking lot and back up to the restaurant entry door on February 23, 2016. The license plate was unreadable. A B/M wearing a train conductor style hat, dark waist length jacket, light colored cargo pants, and light colored shoes exited the vehicle with a broken piece of a cinder block in his hand. He looked around for a few seconds before throwing the block through the glass of the front entry door. The male entered the store and walked briskly directly to the cash register. He picked up the cash register pulling it away from the counter and its electrical cords, and fled the store. The male re-entered the vehicle with the register, left the parking lot, and drove away eastbound on 12 Mile Rd.

After arriving at the residence Officers discovered that a male subject that had just left the residence had assaulted female that lives at the residence.

It was also reported that Staff from a nearby Hospital were in the process of reporting incident to the Police.

The suspect was located by Officers and the suspect was taken into custody.

The suspect resisted arrest, attempted to flee, refused to be put into the back seat of the Patrol Vehicle.

The suspect continued to resist Officers and threaten Officers all the way into the station and when he was brought into the jail he continued to be combative.

It was later discovered that the suspect had severely beaten and punched victim several times.

Officers went to the hospital to interview the victim.

Officers discovered that the victim had sustained severe injuries.

The suspect was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault, Resist & Obstruct Officer & Possession of Prescription Medication.

Detectives presented case to OCPO and suspect was arraigned on all charges.

The victim stated her ex-boyfriend approached her from behind as she was entering her apartment building. The suspect assaulted the victim and forced her into her apartment. The victim stated that the suspect sexually assaulted her inside of the apartment. The suspect fled the scene in a 2008 Dodge Charger, Black in color.

Victim contacted her brother and together they came into the station and reported incident to Desk Officer who took the original report. A Southfield Police Evidence Technician responded to the station and took photos of victim's injuries.

Evidence Technician then went to victim's apartment, processed scene and collected several items of evidence.

Probable cause was established for the arrest of suspect.
